FROM OUR PASTOR



Brothers and sisters,

Merry Christmas! This weekend we celebrate the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. Usually we think of these three, but we also remember the extended family of Jesus – cousins, aunts and uncles, other relatives in the village – all of whom were a blessing to Jesus and who were blessed by Jesus, even as a child. In the humble life of love in Bethlehem, Nazareth, and Jerusalem, we ourselves learn from the Holy Family how to love one another.

One thing that families do is celebrate. And celebration is an art. Birthdays, holidays, weddings, even funerals and times of mourning – these are all special moments that include family rituals. Even the most secular modern family inevitably develops habits and customs that become quasi-liturgical. “This is how we like to do things, because this is who we are.” Celebrating is important because celebration points us to God, whether known to us or not. Celebrating brings us out of ourselves toward something greater.

How can Christian families practice the art of celebrating well? Here are three tips:

1. Honor each family member with words on a special day. To honor someone is to speak words of blessing, thankfulness, and admiration before them in the presence of others. We honor others not because of their innate gifts, but because of the virtues they have cultivated and because of what they mean to us. In my household, everyone seated at table shares an “honoring” of one of the brothers on his birthday. It is always rich, intimate, and bonding. And to be honest, it takes practice.
2. Celebrate the Church’s seasons of celebration. Christmas and Easter are more than a day, they are seasons! If it has ever felt like you put so much work in preparing for Christmas, and then it blows by in 10 seconds, you might be forgetting this important point. For centuries, Christians have spent days and weeks keeping up the festivity and joy of our salvation in Christ.
3. Finally, keep the Lord’s Day holy. Every Sunday is a miniature Easter. It is no surprise that when a family forgets to keep the Lord’s Day by coming to worship, the rest of the week gets a little less joyful and a bit more like drudgery. Our Eucharistic celebration is the greatest one of all – it’s a time to rest, remember, listen, sing, and be fed by Christ.

May these practices bless you and yours this Christmas season and all year long.

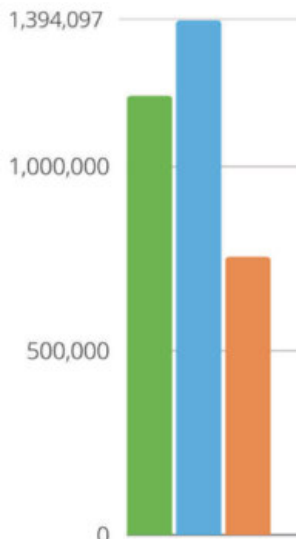

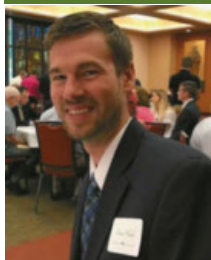
Thank you for your faithful stewardship!
This information is updated every 3rd Sunday.

As of the end of November 2021, of the **\$1,394,097** pledged, we have collected **\$1,189,757**. Thank you for your contributions. Please remember checks for the campaign should be made out to Saint Rose of Lima.

So far we have contributed \$300,000 to our endowments, and allocated \$117,025 toward capital campaign expenses. We have spent \$224,474 on the preschool initiative (landscaping, playground and security system), \$34,462 on new ministries (Catechesis of the Good Shepherd and livestreaming technology), \$40,851 in capital improvements, primarily related to parking lot improvements, and \$36,346 on the Chapel renovation. The total spent thus far is **\$753,732**.

OUR PEOPLE – PARISH STAFF



Brian Hindt's journey from growing up in a Pittsburgh household where his parents were a great witness on how to live a Christian life to the blessings he brings to his ministry as Saint Rose Parish Pastoral Associate has been marked by some very significant inflection points.

Inspiring book. Brian was 23 years old and working at a bank in Pittsburgh when a colleague recommended reading a book about Padre Pio, a friar, priest, stigmatist and mystic known for his charity and piety who became a saint in 2002. "At the time I did not have a very thorough knowledge of my Catholic faith," he says. "I was going to Mass but did not understand what was happening in front of me. Reading about this Saint transformed my life. Later, I started going to daily Mass, which helped me grow in my relationship with God and find peace and direction in my work."

Helping the less fortunate. Another work friend of Brian's, who was a very strong Christian, invited him to join her in ministering to the homeless in downtown Pittsburgh. "At that time I realized my happiness came from serving others," he says. "Doing something as simple as having a conversation and praying with someone going through a hardship brought me something that was missing in my life—interior happiness."

New calling. When Brian lived in Charlotte and spent much time with his terminally ill father he saw first-hand the power of prayer as his father's physical and spiritual health improved drastically after telling others of his condition and asking for prayer. It was during this time that Brian had a strong calling to "follow Jesus" wherever He leads. After his father's death he moved back to Pittsburgh, worked for a Catholic Church and later entered St. Paul Seminary in Pittsburgh. "The Seminary was a great experience, but after two years I felt the Lord calling me elsewhere. I felt called to stay connected with the Catholic Church but as a Pastoral Associate. I also desired to reconnect with my family; none were left in Pittsburgh. Almost all lived in Minnesota."

Next stop: Roseville. Brian officially withdrew himself from the seminary on August 23, the Feast Day of St. Rose of Lima. He recalls going to daily Mass on that day and afterwards praying with two friends for St. Rose's intercession for all the unemployed which included himself. He credits St. Rose of Lima's intercession for his current position.

"In the more than two years I have been here, I've learned—first and foremost—that the parish has an amazing group of volunteers," he says. "Each person has special gifts and talents that the Lord is calling them to utilize. So many parishioners have unique skill sets. It has been very beneficial to our parish community to help them determine how best to use their special gifts to make an impact and help them follow the path the Lord is calling them."

Other things to know about Brian:

- Brian grew up in Pittsburgh and attended Our Lady of Grace School and Chartiers Valley High School. He was the leading scorer (nearly 20 points per game) on the 2004 large school Western Pennsylvania championship basketball team. An injury cut short his basketball ambitions at Seton Hill College. He transferred to Duquesne University where he graduated with a degree in finance and investment management. After college he worked for several years at PNC Bank.
- Although he has only lived here a few years, Brian says Minnesota is home to him. His sister, aunts, uncles, cousins and grandfather all live here.
- Brian's duties as Pastoral Associate include: Being the main contact for families making funeral arrangements; helping and supporting parishioners going through hardships; overseeing and creating new parish adult and family ministries; meeting and connecting new parishioners; organizing gatherings and events; assisting the Christian Services Committee and Adoration Chapel team; and helping others in their faith journey. One of his main goals is to bring people together and help them grow their faith.

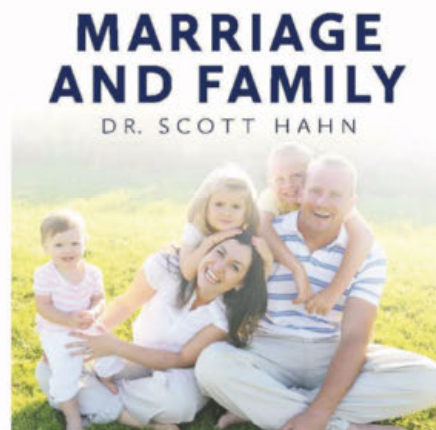

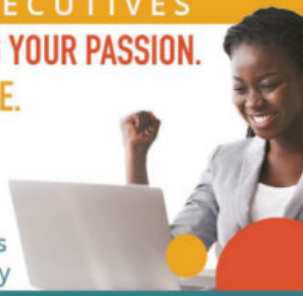
