



EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP

RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS I Hope I Am Like Him

"Who is this Christ? Is he like you?"

Perhaps you've heard this story, often attributed to the life of St. Teresa of Calcutta. A sick man asked her this question, as he marveled at her tireless service to himself and others in the name of someone named Jesus Christ.

"He is nothing like me," the saint is said to have answered. "But I hope I am like him."

Though the authenticity of this exchange cannot be verified, its message rings perfectly true: all the value of our stewardship lies in its relativity to the one in whose name we perform it.

Consider the figure of John the Baptist — a magnificent, towering character even purely from a literary or historical perspective. A martyr who fed on wild locusts and boldly spoke truth to power — a man so great some mistook him for the Messiah.

But why is he great? Because he prepared the way. All his accomplishments and escapades mean nothing if they are taken out of the context of salvation history. He only makes sense relative to Christ — and this is exactly as he wanted it. "One worthier than I is coming," he insists. And because of that humility and that total embrace of God's will, he is given one of the greatest honors in the New Testament — he baptizes the Son of God.

Let's examine our lives in the light of their relativity to Christ. How do we prepare the way? When Christ comes to us, what do we do? How do we leave ourselves open to be actors in God's plan?



Parish Stewardship

November Actual:\$95,931.77 November Budget:\$79,843.00

Thank you for your faithful stewardship! This information is updated every 3rd Sunday.

As of the end of November 2021, of the \$1,394,097 pledged, we have collected \$1,189,757. Thank you for your contributions. Please remember checks for the campaign should be made out to Saint Rose of Lima.

So far we have contributed \$300,000 to our endowments, and allocated \$117,025 toward capital campaign expenses. We have spent \$224,474 on the preschool initiative (landscaping, playground and security system), \$34,462 on new ministries (Catechesis of the Good Shepherd and livestreaming technology), \$40,851 in capital improvements, primarily related to parking lot improvements, and \$36,346 on the Chapel renovation. The total spent thus far is \$753,732.

OUR PEOPLE



Livestreaming is a growing ministry at Saint Rose—Masses, funerals, weddings, school graduation and special events—are available for viewing on the parish website, Facebook and YouTube. Making it all work is parishioner Keith Flanagan, who coordinates the productions (along with Joey Stepnick).

"As this ministry expands we need more volunteers to help produce what goes out over the air," says Keith. "No experience is necessary; we will train you."

When it comes to training Keith knows of what he speaks. He has 30 years of video production experience as a volunteer at community television (CTV and Roseville area schools). During that time he has done audio and graphics, been a camera and teleprompter operator, director and producer. He even kept the high school marching bands on schedule during the annual Rosefest parade. Keith received the public access television equivalent of an Emmy three times.

Now on their third generation of livestreaming equipment (starting with Fr. Paveglio's cell phone) Keith and Joey have simplified the job for volunteers by creating directions on which of the three cameras to use at each point in the Mass.

"I really enjoy working in this ministry," says Keith. "It gives me a chance to do the evangelization that I can't do in person. I want people watching at home to feel they are in church."

In addition to his experience in community television production, Keith has a long history as a flight instructor. After serving in the Air Force in Vietnam as a radio operator, he returned home and spent 21 years as a member of the Air National Guard. Keith has both a private and commercial pilot license and is a certified flight instructor. "I've trained scores of pilots in my career," he says. "When it comes to flying and television production, I've learned alot and enjoy passing information and knowledge on to others."

Other things to know about Keith:

- He was born and raised on the East Side of St. Paul and attended Transfiguration School and Nazareth Hall Preparatory Seminary for high school. On two occasions Keith considered becoming a priest, but those opportunities never materialized. He graduated from the University of St. Thomas with a degree in theology.
- In the mid-1980s, when St. John's Hospital was looking to relocate from St. Paul to a suburban location, Keith flew a real estate agent and two architects over a site in Maplewood as they evaluated the property where the new hospital was eventually built. Later he became a regular Eucharistic minister (from St. John the Evangelist in Little Canada) at the same hospital. He hopes to join the Saint Rose team when they return to bringing Communion to patients.
- Keith is also a lector, cantor and member of the choir.
- In addition to his military service Keith worked for the U.S. Postal Service for 17 years.


