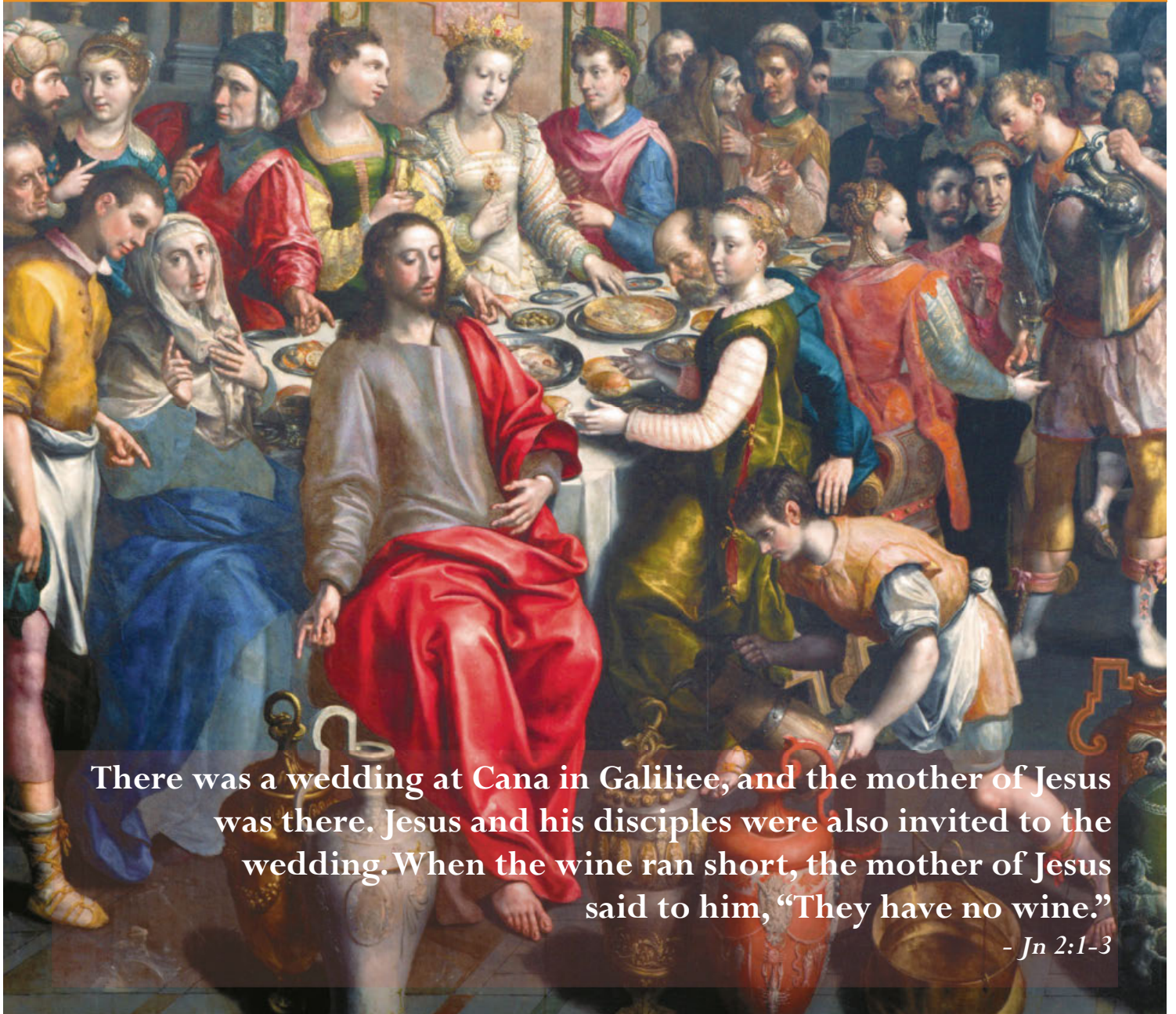

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

It Takes All Kinds

“If every flower wanted to be a rose,” wrote St. Therese of Lisieux, “spring would lose its loveliness.”

Who is God asking you to be today? There is an obvious answer that springs to mind right out of the gate. God wants me to be a good person (a good father, a good husband) today; today, God wants me to be a saint.

But this answer fails to get to the heart of the question. We are all striving today to serve the same Spirit, but we are given different gifts to do so. The one who has the gift of knowledge may fail if today he decides he wants to be a healer. The one who has the gift of “varieties of tongues” might falter in the expression of wisdom.

Think about the wedding at Cana and the players in the scene: the servers, the guests, the bride and groom. They all have a unique role to play, and though it is to the servers that Mary gives the instruction, “Do whatever he tells you,” her words apply to all.

Today, are we called to be the servers — do we wait on God’s instruction and carry it out, no matter how foolish or impossible it may seem to our human ears? Are we asked to be the disciples, to bear witness to a miracle and to give our testimony? Are we called to imitate the Blessed Mother herself and give encouragement to follow God’s word?

Let us examine our gifts and listen in the silence of our hearts to the direction of the Spirit. Then and only then, let us do whatever He tells us.

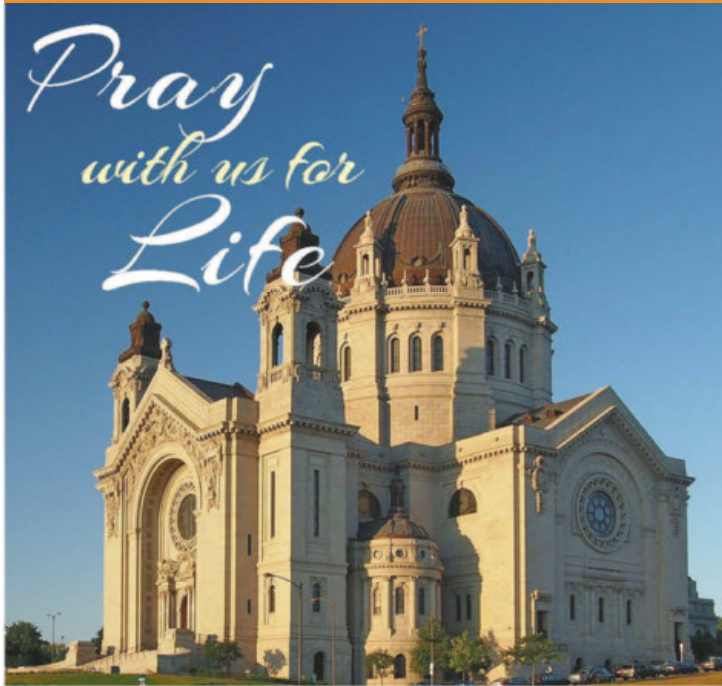

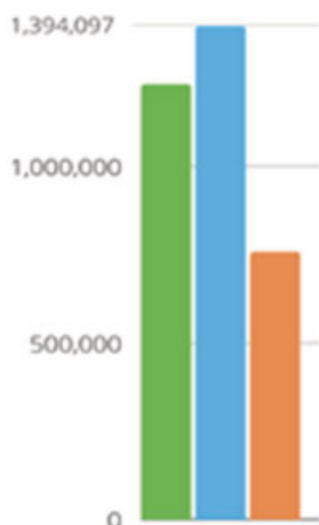

CAMPAIGN UPDATE & STEWARDSHIP



Parish Stewardship

December Actual:\$113,742.34
 December Budget:\$86,843.00

*Thank you for your faithful stewardship!
 This information is updated every 3rd Sunday.*

As of the end of December 2021, of the **\$1,394,097** pledged, we have collected **\$1,230,101**. Thank you for your contributions. Please remember checks for the campaign should be made out to Saint Rose of Lima.

So far we have contributed \$300,000 to our endowments, and allocated \$117,025 toward capital campaign expenses. We have spent \$224,474 on the preschool initiative (landscaping, playground and security system), \$34,462 on new ministries (Catechesis of the Good Shepherd and livestreaming technology), \$40,851 in capital improvements, primarily related to parking lot improvements, and \$39,346 on the Chapel renovation. The total spent thus far is **\$756,732**.

OUR PEOPLE



Long before email and texting there were letters. Remember letters? Parishioners Maurice (Mick) and Van Michalek certainly do—about 400 of them in 400 days. That's how many Mick, a returning Vietnam war veteran, sent to Van who he met at Pasteur Institute in Saigon.

His diligent letter writing paid off in 1968 when Van, with a Master's degree in biochemistry, came to the Twin Cities to start her internship at Children's Hospital. Two years later the life-long Catholics were married at Blessed Sacrament Church.

Mick grew up on the East Side of St. Paul and graduated from Wisconsin State University (River Falls) with a degree in medical technology. He worked at several area hospitals before retiring from St. Paul Children's Hospital.

Van is also retired after working for 42 years at the University of Minnesota Medical Center Department of Surgery. She was the Metabolic Bariatric Surgery laboratory's manager. Van is co-inventor and co-patent holder of three medical devices—two for determining blood oxygen transport and another for a non-invasive micro-orifice surgical access system.

The Michalek family joined Saint Rose in 1982; their sons attended the parish school. Chris, the oldest, passed away suddenly in 2010 of a brain aneurism at age 39.

"That was the most difficult period in our lives," says Mick. "Our strong Catholic faith allowed us to survive and move forward despite the wound that would never heal. Our time in the Perpetual Adoration Chapel helped us as well." Van and Mick signed up as regular Adorers the first week the Chapel opened in 1989 and have missed their scheduled hour only about 10 times.

Other things to know about Van and Mick:

- Mick volunteers every week at Feed My Starving Children.
- Van, who became a U.S. citizen in 1976, has been a very active and respected volunteer in the local Southeast Asian community. She and Mick have sponsored several seminarians in Vietnam; four became priests. They are currently sponsoring additional seminarians and young women entering nunhood.
- A book of 200 poems written by Van has been published. In total, she has written about 2,000 poems.
- The Michaleks have two other sons—Dominique and Patrick, one grandchild and three great grandchildren.
