



Pensamientos de Padre Jonathan Davis :

El mes de enero está dedicado a honrar el Santísimo Nombre de Jesús. El 3 de enero fue la Fiesta del Santo Nombre. El nombre de Jesús significa “Dios salva”. Dios verdaderamente nos ha salvado a través de Jesucristo, quien es Dios hecho carne. El Nombre de Jesús merece nuestra mayor veneración, respeto y amor. San Pablo en su carta a los Filipenses escribió: “En el nombre de Jesús, toda rodilla se doble en los cielos, en la tierra y debajo de la tierra, y toda lengua proclame para la gloria de Dios Padre: Jesucristo es el Señor.” (2:10-11). San Bernardino de Siena (1380-1444) y San Juan de Capistrano (1386-1456) promovieron la devoción al Santo Nombre. En sus misiones levantarían un símbolo del Santo Nombre con las letras IHS rodeadas de rayos y bendijeron a la gente con este mientras invocando el nombre de Jesús. Ocurrieron muchos milagros. IHS es una abreviatura del nombre de Jesús en griego. Recomendaron a la gente que escribiera este símbolo sobre las puertas de sus hogares y por encima de las puertas de la ciudad. Puedes ver estas letras pintadas en las paredes de nuestro santuario detrás del altar de nuestra iglesia. Solo decir el nombre de Jesús es una oración en sí misma. Invocar el nombre de Jesús ha demostrado traer curaciones, protección contra el mal, e innumerables gracias de todo tipo. Hoy, no hay otro nombre que es amada y blasfemada por tanta mucha gente. Es un insulto directo a Dios y a Su Santo Rostro. A partir del año de 1840, una joven monja carmelita en Tours, Francia, la Hna. María de San Pedro, comenzó a recibir revelaciones de nuestro Señor sobre una poderosa devoción que Él quería establecer en todo el mundo, que es la devoción a Su Santo Rostro. Él le dijo que el propósito de esta devoción es reparar los pecados de blasfemia de Su Santo Nombre, así como los pecados de los comunistas, ateos y la profanación del domingo por parte de los cristianos. Dijo, al ofrecer su Santo Rostro a Dios, “harás milagros”, “obtendrás la conversión de muchos pecadores”, y “nada de lo que pidas al hacer esta ofrenda será rechazado”. Con frecuencia debemos adorar el Rostro de Cristo y ofrecerlo a Dios en reparación de los pecados. Aquí hay una oración que podemos rezar cada día:

“Padre Eterno, te ofrecemos el Santo Rostro de Jesús, cubierto de sangre, sudor, polvo y saliva, en reparación por los crímenes de los comunistas, blasfemos y profanadores del Santo Nombre y del Santo Día del Domingo. Amén.”



Thoughts by Fr. Jonathan Davis:

The month of January is dedicated to honoring the Most Holy Name of Jesus. January 3rd was the Feast of the Holy Name. The name of Jesus means “God saves.” God has truly saved us through Jesus Christ, Who is God in the flesh. The Name of Jesus deserves our utmost veneration, respect, and love. St. Paul in his letter to the Philippians wrote, “At the name of Jesus, every knee must bend in the heavens, on the earth and under the earth, and every tongue proclaim to the glory of God the Father: Jesus Christ is Lord” (2:10-11). St. Bernardino of Sienna (1380-1444) and St. John of Capistrano (1386-1456) promoted devotion to the Holy Name. In their missions they would raise a symbol of the Holy Name with the letters IHS surrounded by rays and bless the people with it while invoking the name of Jesus. Many miracles occurred. I-H-S is an abbreviation of the name of Jesus in Greek. They recommended the people to write this symbol above the doorways to their homes and above the city gates. You can see these letters painted on the walls of our sanctuary behind the altar in our church. Just saying the name of Jesus is a prayer in itself. Invoking the name of Jesus has shown to bring healings, protection from evil, and innumerable graces of every kind. Today, there is no other name which is at the same time loved and blasphemed by so many people. It is a direct insult to God and to His Holy Face. Beginning in the 1840s a young Carmelite nun in Tours, France, Sr. Mary of St. Peter, began to receive revelations from our Lord about a powerful devotion that He wanted to establish throughout the world which is devotion to His Holy Face. He told her that the purpose of this devotion is to

make reparation for the sins of blasphemy of His Holy Name as well as the sins of Communists, atheists, and the profanation of Sunday by Christians. He said, by offering his Holy Face to God, “you will work miracles,” “you will obtain the conversion of many sinners,” and “nothing you ask in making this offering will be refused.” We should frequently adore the Face of Christ and offer It to God in reparation for sins. Here is a prayer that we can pray each day:

“Eternal Father, we offer You the Holy Face of Jesus, covered with blood, sweat, dust and spittle, in reparation for the crimes of communists, blasphemers, and for the profaners of the Holy Name and of the Holy Day of Sunday. Amen.”

The Golden Arrow Prayer

Jesus gave Sr. Mary of St. Peter this prayer to make reparation for sins and to console Jesus' Heart which is so wounded by blasphemers of his Holy Name. After receiving this prayer, she was given a vision in which she saw the Sacred Heart of Jesus delightfully wounded by this "Golden Arrow" as torrents of graces streamed from it for the conversion of sinners.

*May the most holy, most sacred,
most adorable, most mysterious and unutterable Name of God
be always praised, blessed, loved, adored and
glorified in heaven on earth and under the earth,
by all the creatures of God,
and by the Sacred Heart of our Lord Jesus Christ
in the most Holy Sacrament of the altar.
Amen.*


