Vigil Mass for Pentecost: Saturday, June 4

All are invited to join us for the extended form Vigil Mass for Pentecost at 7:00 PM on Saturday, June 4 at the Church of St. Michael. (This Mass will replace the 4:30 PM Anticipatory Mass, though confessions will still be heard from 3:00-4:15 PM). Dating back to the early Church, this exquisite form of the Pentecost Vigil refers back to the Easter Vigil with additional readings and responsorial psalms highlighting the Holy Spirit's role in the life of the Church. We will pray for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit while celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation for RCIA Candidates at this Mass. Please join us: *Veni, Sancte Spiritus!*

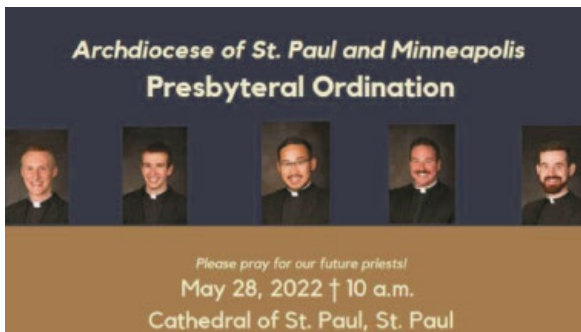
