



A Message From Our School Principal **Betsy Osterhaus-Hand**

There are times when I can't remember what educating was like before the pandemic. I know I thought leading a school was complex and challenging, but recently I've needed to pause and reflect on what kept me hopping before this virus. Well, that isn't actually true. King of the Snow Hill continues to result

in recess conflicts. Cutting and pasting online paragraphs and submitting it as one's own is still plagiarism, and running in the halls is...you get the idea.

Sometimes people have the perception that there aren't any problems in Catholic schools, and that our students are angelic. While I would say that our Saint Ambrose classroom environment is overall calm and focused, and that we have an incredible faculty who work hard to establish positive relationships with every student, we are a school full of human beings who sometimes make choices that are hurtful to others. This is why it is a blessing to lead a Catholic school.

When we humans make poor choices, we are given an opportunity to work on a holy habit, or a virtue. At Saint Ambrose, working through conflict resolution means owning one's part of the issue, identifying and naming the virtue that was missing from the action, asking for forgiveness to those injured, and hopefully moving to a place of freedom with this holy habit in mind. We work to form virtuous humans who generously live from love. I am privileged to work closely with students and witness these moments of contrition, and often of demystifying the "other" that they were upset with during the conflict. Our hope is to form our students in the vocabulary of virtue to encourage them to live with "a firm disposition to do the good", as our Catechism states.

As a school, generosity is our virtue of focus this year. If we can live generously, we are truly establishing the practice of a holy habit that makes us like God. We are celebrating generous choices that unselfishly offer love, support, and often buoy another person who could be flagging. I am grateful for the generous staff at Saint Ambrose whose teamwork, energy, and commitment to students is unwavering. I am also appreciative of the generous students who share their natural gifts willingly. Additionally, a big thanks to our parents who continue to partner with us, supporting our important work in countless ways.

As we navigate educating with unique pandemic challenges as well as typical "kid" behaviors, we welcome your generous prayers of support.

Episcopal Ordination of Bishop - elect Joseph A. Williams



Are you looking for a way to engage your child in the weekly readings at Mass? We are now taking orders for families who would like to get weekly pamphlets to engage children ages 6-12.


MagnifiKid is the ideal spiritual guide for your children, perfectly adapted to their lives:




