## Feast of the Epiphany - Fr. Leo

When King Herod hears from the magi that they were looking for a new born king of the Jews, he loses it. How is it that a king can be threatened by a baby? Such an odd response, but he gets all bent out of shape and knives and plots to find and kill this infant.

Obviously, Herod felt threatened, and his jealousy made him respond in a very immature manner. Jealousy does that. It brings the worst out of people. Think of the attack on an Olympic skater by a friend of another some years ago. Or what mothers might do to have their daughter on the cheerleading squad.

I think there is still a lot of jealousy in the world and even in the Church. Monks can even become jealous of other monks if they think they are "doing" better than they. But the irony in this is that **God's gift to one person is a gift to us all**. This is why the monks pray for each other in love when there is no false ego-self and jealousy in their hearts

If Herod could have known what a blessing Christ would have been for him and his kingdom, not a threat, he may have truly sought the child out in love. Jealousy is blinding and we all struggle with jealousy from time to time, if we are honest. What might help, is to meditate on the humility of the magi in today's reading. They come from a far and offer in faith their most precious gifts, gold, frankincense and myrrh, but more importantly, themselves.

They knelt before the infant and in honoring him received God's gift to us all; the savior of the world. So God's grace which is love can not produce jealousy, and with love we would long for all to be blessed that we might be in turn, blessed by them! Let us pray to God to bless all humanity this day, that the peoples of the earth may walk in the light of the epiphany of God. Lord, shine your light on us and lead us into the fullness of your Kingdom. Amen.

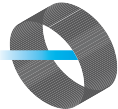
