**April is Child Abuse Prevention Month.** We believe every child has a right to a safe childhood free of violence. As some of the most vulnerable in our society, children are worthy of growing up in a safe, healthy and supportive environment. Unfortunately, millions of young people are abused, ignored, and mistreated by the adults responsible to create that positive environment. **Child abuse** are acts that result in serious harm or risk of harm, including physical violence, exploitation, and death. Failure to take action to stop the harm is also considered child abuse. **Child neglect** is the failure to provide a child's basic needs that range from providing clean clothing to medical care. The healing journey for those who have experienced child abuse and neglect can be very painful. It IS possible for survivors to go on and have healthy and productive childhoods and adult lives.

### ~ SOCIAL CONCERNS CORNER ~

**Catholic Relief Services brings hope:** The World Health Organization reports 844 million people don't have access to safe water. About 2.3 billion people are living without access to improved sanitation. That means 1 in 9 people on the planet don't have clean water close to home. One in 3 don't have a decent toilet.

CRS supports water, sanitation and hygiene services in more than 30 countries, focusing on services for the poorest and most remote communities. Many of their clean water projects are focused on sub-Saharan Africa.

For example, in Madagascar more than 680 rehabilitated or new, protected water points were installed. Now 62,325 people have access to drinking water and 97,685 people use latrines constructed by households/communities without subsidies.

In many places around the world, women manage the household water supply, often walking long distances to retrieve it. Water is life, as drinking, bathing and cooking rely on it. In Ethiopia, CRS has supported a watershed management program. Hillside terracing and sustainable land use planning help to naturally replenish exhausted water supplies. Communities now have access to more water, which has increased crop production, generated more income and improved overall health.

Each step that is taken gives hope to our brothers and sisters, hope for the future. We contribute to the gift of hope when we give to CRS.
