#### **Dear Brothers and Sisters,**

This week the Church celebrates the lives of three very influential saints. We begin the week with St. Mary Magdalen, half way through we have St. James the Apostle and we end the week with St. Joachim and Anne, parents of Mary. All three of these saints were greatly impacted by Jesus I want to focus on St. Joachim and Anne, who were the grandparents of Jesus. While you won't find any mention of them in scripture, the Church fathers wrote of them and their role of the life of raising Mary in a home that God was honored. We can only speculate whether or not Sts. Joachim and Anne would have met and known Jesus in their lives, if they would have lived to see him. Tradition tells us that Mary was young when she gave birth to Jesus, so we can infer that they would have had a significant role in his life.

Mary's upbringing, being raised in a home where God was put first, would have had an impact on the way that she raised Jesus. This would have been something so deeply a part of her, that praising God and bringing honor to Him would have flowed within her own family life.

The Second Vatican Council taught, "The family is, so to speak, the domestic church. In it parents should, by their word and example, be the first preachers of the faith to their children; they should encourage them in the vocation that is proper to each of them, fostering with special care vocation to a sacred state" (LG 11). St. John Paul II wrote about how the family is a "church in miniature" (*ecclesia domestica*), such that in its own way the family is a living image and historical representation of the mystery of the church. (*Familiaris Consortio* 49).

Let us pray through the powerful intercession of Sts. Joachim and Anne so that our homes may be a place where God is glorified and vocations are promoted!

### ~ SOCIAL CONCERNS CORNER ~

**An Ecological Conversion:** "The world needs an ecological "conversion" in order to manifest the Church's vision of an integral human ecology" says Pope Francis. "Adequate responses to current problems cannot be superficial. Rather, what is needed is precisely a conversion, a 'turning around', that is, a transformation of hearts and minds."

"Striving to overcome problems such as hunger and food insecurity, persistent social and economic distress, the degradation of ecosystem and a 'culture of waste' calls for a renewed ethical vision, one that places persons in the center, desiring to leave no one on the margins of life," says the Holy Father.

"The work of building up a person-centered, integral ecology is both a 'call and a task.' It is a call to rediscover our identity as sons and daughters of our heavenly Father who have been created in the divine image and commissioned to be stewards of the earth; re-created through the saving death and resurrection of Jesus Christ; and sanctified by the gift of the Holy Spirit."

He calls for "a growing investment in renewable and sustainable energy sources; new methods of energy efficiency; and a greater sensitivity, especially among young people, to ecological concerns."
