The "40 Days for Life" campaign is fast approaching. This year the date are Sept. 25 - Nov. 3. Within our Area Catholic Community, there will be opportunities to join in the fight to end abortion. Please see the bulletin for more details.

Very recently I watched the film "Unplanned". This movie is about a former Planned Parenthood employee, Abby Johnson, who witnessed the suffering of mothers in need of help and realized that abortion did not actually help them, but caused them more pain. Through experiencing two abortions of her own, and witnessing other women go through abortion, she came to the realization that abortion is the taking of innocent life. She is now a leading advocate in the fight for life.

On September 29th we will be showing the film "Unplanned" at St. Mary's in Milaca at 3 p.m. A warning that this is indeed a graphic film and does not hold back on showing the truth of what an abortion is. Your entire family is welcome, but children will need an explanation beforehand of what they are going to see. We will also have a discussion afterwards.

Breakfast Coming! Join us next Sunday, **Sept. 22 at St. Mary's Parish Center between 9 a.m. and noon** for the KC Breakfast. This is an annual fundraiser for the Mora Crisis Pregnancy Center. The MCPC works with single mothers through pregnancy and delivery. They also conduct parenting programs.

Fr. Derek is looking for married couples to help him prepare engaged couples for the Sacrament of Marriage for both St. Mary's and St. Kathryn's parishes. Our parishes use the Fully Engaged program, created by the Diocese of St. Cloud. Sponsor couples assist in this preparation. While Fr. Derek offers the engaged couples the theological and liturgical aspects of marriage a sponsor couple can offer them practical examples of married life such as prayer, communication, family life, and other important aspects.
