Breakfast TODAY! Join us TODAY, Sunday, Sept. 22 at St. Mary's Parish Center between 9 a.m. and noon for the annual KC Breakfast fundraiser for the Mora Crisis Pregnancy Center. The MCPC works with single mothers through pregnancy and after delivery. They also conduct parenting programs.

St. Mary/Kathryn Guild Food Collection for Kids at Schools: St. Mary/Kathryn Guild will be taking a one time collection at Masses during the week-end of Sept. 28-29. At St. Kathryn's 50 backpacks are filled twice a month to give out at school. Checks written to Ogilvie Food Shelf marked "Backpacks" are preferred because food is purchased from Second Harvest.
