A Message From our Pastor

This weekend we celebrate the great Feast of the Epiphany which leads us to the great Feast of the Baptism of the Lord next weekend. The feast of the Baptism of the Lord concludes our Christmas season. The Christmas season is brief. Though it is brief, it is filled with a lot of opportunities to meditate upon God's goodness to us. The feast of the Baptism of the Lord gets us thinking about our baptisms. Many of you have attended a Catholic baptism. One of the more powerful moments is when the parents and godparents commit to raising the child in the practice of our Catholic faith and renew their baptismal promises.

I include the text from the baptismal rite:

By water and the Holy Spirit, he (she) is to receive the gift of new life from God, who is love. On your part, you must make it your constant care to bring him (her) up in the practice of the faith. See that the divine life which God gives him (her) is kept safe from the poison of sin, to grow always stronger in his (her) heart. If your faith makes you ready to accept this responsibility, renew now the vows of your own baptism. Reject sin; profess your faith in Christ Jesus. This is the faith of the Church. This is the faith in which this child is about to be baptized.

CELEBRANT: Do you reject sin, so as to live in the freedom of God's children? PARENTS AND GODPARENTS: I do. CELEBRANT: Do you reject the glamor of evil, and refuse to be mastered by sin? PARENTS AND GODPARENTS: I do. CELEBRANT: Do you reject Satan, father of sin and prince of darkness? PARENTS AND GÖDPARENTS: I do.

CELEBRANT: Do you believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth? PARENTS AND GODPARENTS: I do. CELEBRANT: Do vou believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was born of the Virgin Mary, was crucified, died, and was buried, rose from the dead, and is now seated at the right hand of the Father? PARENTS AND GODPARENTS: I do. CELEBRANT: Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting? PARENTS AND GODPARENTS: I do.

CELEBRANT: This is our faith. This is the faith of the Church. We are proud to profess it, in Christ Jesus our Lord. All: Amen.

I want to place the emphasis on the word *proud*. We should be proud to profess our Catholic faith and pass it on to the next generations. We do this by praying together at home, by talking about our faith, by being good obedient servants, and by getting to church regularly. This responsibility is not primarily a burden. It is the greatest blessing to participate in our relationship with God and to help other people to do the same.

As we begin another year of life, let us celebrate the gift of life and baptism, and let us renew our commitment to sharing our Catholic faith.

I wish you a blessed new year. May the peace of the Lord be with you always.


