SERVE

“You shall worship the Lord, your God, and him alone shall you serve.”

LUKE 4:8



2ND SUNDAY OF LENT

While he was still speaking, a cloud came and cast a shadow over them, and they became frightened when they entered the cloud. Then from the cloud came a voice that said, "This is my chosen Son; listen to him." - Lk 9:34-35

A MESSAGE FROM FR. BLAKE

A coach leads his or her team in practice. Practice allows the team to encounter different scenarios. In encountering different scenarios and learning how to deal with the scenarios, the team becomes stronger when the team encounters similar scenarios in games.

A teacher provides exams and papers for his or her students. Through the exams and papers, the students are given skills and tools that can aid them in what life will bring their way.

Testing and trials can be a very good thing. They can strengthen us as individuals and as members of a team. The letter of St. James, chapter 1, verses 2-4 states: "Count it all joy, my brethren, when you meet various trials, for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness. And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing." Our trials can aid us in being the people we are called to be. Our trials can also aid us in attaining the perfect paradise of Heaven if we allow ourselves to learn from our trials and be formed by them. They will aid us in doing the good and avoiding evil.

Lent is a time of trial and testing. Mother Church provides this opportunity for her children to be strengthened in their faith. Lent can help us to persevere toward our goal of Heaven. Pope Francis encourages us to meditate upon agricultural imagery as we begin this Lenten season. The following excerpts are from his 2022 Lenten message:

"Dear Brothers and Sisters, Lent is a favourable time for personal and community renewal, as it leads us to the paschal mystery of the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. For our Lenten journey in 2022, we will do well to reflect on

Saint Paul's exhortation to the Galatians: 'Let us not grow tired of doing good, for in due time we shall reap our harvest, if we do not give up. So then, while we have the opportunity (kairós), let us do good to all' (Gal 6:9-10)."

"In this season of conversion, sustained by God's grace and by the communion of the Church, let us not grow tired of doing good. The soil is prepared by fasting, watered by prayer and enriched by charity. Let us believe firmly that 'if we do not give up, we shall reap our harvest in due time' and that, with the gift of perseverance, we shall obtain what was promised (cf. Heb 10:36), for our salvation and the salvation of others (cf. 1 Tim 4:16). By cultivating fraternal love towards everyone, we are united to Christ, who gave his life for our sake (cf. 2 Cor 5:14-15), and we are granted a foretaste of the joy of the kingdom of heaven, when God will be 'all in all' (1 Cor 15:28)."

Let us make the most of this opportunity.

May the peace of the Lord be with you always.
