

#### A MESSAGE FROM OUR SHEPHERD

uring the month of May, we continue to honor Mary. I love that the Church crowns our Blessed Mother at the beginning of this month. That moment always brings me great peace. Probably because the kids are so happy in crowning Mary. This experience also makes sense considering that Mary is the Queen of Peace and her Son, our Savior, is the Prince of Peace. It is pleasing to Him that we turn to Mary.

I came across the following excerpt from the Second Vatican Council document *Lumen Gentium* (Light for the Nations). It is portion of paragraph 62:

This motherhood of Mary in the order of grace continues uninterruptedly from the consent which she loyally gave at the Annunciation and which she sustained without wavering beneath the cross, until the eternal fulfilment of all the elect. Taken up to heaven she did not lay aside this saving office but by her manifold intercession continues to bring us the gifts of eternal salvation. By her maternal charity, she cares for the brethren of her Son, who still journey on earth surrounded by dangers and difficulties, until they are led into their blessed home. Therefore the Blessed Virgin is invoked in the Church under the titles of Advocate, Helper, Benefactress, and Mediatrix. This, however, is so understood that it neither takes away anything from nor adds anything to the dignity and efficacy of Christ the one Mediator.

I appreciate the clause, "she did not lay aside this saving office but by her manifold intercession continues to bring us the gifts of eternal salvation". What an opportunity to turn to Mary throughout our days! What a blessing! We do not need to struggle through our "dangers and difficulties" alone. We have the greatest Mother who desires to accompany us.

Run to Mary! Allow her to bless you! She will lead you into deeper union with her Son. We all have access to Mary. She is so approachable. We just need to quiet ourselves and call her name, like we enter conversation with others. She is "full of grace," and she desires to bless us so that we can live in union with God's will, in our thoughts, words, and actions.

May the peace of the Lord be with you always... and the peace of Mary!

#### **ROLE OF A DEACON**

Deacons are members of the clergy along with priests and bishops. Only a bishop can ordain a deacon. Permanent Deacons are assigned by the bishop to parishes or institutions according to the pastoral need of the diocese.

The deacon's ministry has three dimensions: liturgy, word and service. At the liturgy, he assists the bishop and priests. At the Mass, the deacon proclaims the Gospel, may be invited to preach the homily, and assists at the altar. The deacon may also baptize, witness and bless marriages, preside at the Liturgy of the Hours, and conduct wake and funeral services among many other duties.

Living in the world, deacons have a particular sensitivity to the needs of real families – including single parents, students, older people, those with disabilities, the incarcerated and those who suffer from poverty or addictions of many kinds.

The entire Church is called by Christ to serve, and the deacon, in virtue of his sacramental ordination and through his various ministries, is to be a servant in a servant-Church.


