### A MESSAGE FROM OUR SHEPHERD

has concluded, we continue our Church year with two big celebrations in a row: the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity and the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Both solemnities are grace-filled! I pray our hearts are disposed to receive all that the Lord desires to bestow upon us through these celebrations.

In relation to the latter solemnity, a Revival is beginning this year. If you have not yet heard of the movement, I encourage you to check out eucharisticrevival.org. This revival is going to span over the next few years. The Mission of the Revival is To renew the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist.

The Vision of the Revival is
To inspire a movement of
Catholics across the United
States who are healed, converted, formed, and unified
by an encounter with Jesus in
the Eucharist – and who are
then sent out on mission "for
the life of the world."

This is not just another program. We pray, along with Catholics across the country, that this Revival will bring new life and hope into our Church and society today. The Lord, the Giver of Life, desires to show us life through the Eucharist, the Source and Summit of our lives.

The Diocese of Duluth is participating in the Revival, and a Eucharistic procession is happening in

Duluth on June 19, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

In 2015, when we gathered for the diocesan Eucharistic procession to celebrate 125 years as a diocese, an estimated 2000—3000 people were present. Praise God! We have another opportunity to come together as a diocese to kick off this Eucharistic Revival. The procession will depart the cathedral in Duluth at 3:00 pm and will conclude at St. Mary's Star of the Sea. It will be an amazing day! Invite friends, carpool, and take a road trip to Duluth and know the blessing of Almighty God!

In our world that is so broken and divided and scary, it is easy to despair. Allow this day to revive you! We walk through this life with Jesus, and Jesus shepherds and guides us through the Eucharist.

May the peace of the Lord be with you always.
