A MESSAGE FROM OUR SHEPHERD

nd Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every disease and every infirmity" (Matthew 9:35).

We know from reading the Scriptures that Jesus did a lot of healing during His earthly ministry. I think at times how amazing that would have been to be around Jesus when He loved people in this way. Then I realize anew our calling. We are all members of the body of Christ through baptism; we are members of the Church. We read in the Gospel of John that Jesus said: "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will he do, because I go to the Father" (14:12). We have the same mission as Christ because we are one with Him. Often we think about the great things that Jesus did for others a long time ago, but we often forget that Jesus desires to continue to do great things through us, for us and for others.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church, paragraph 1503 states: Christ's compassion toward the sick and his many healings of every kind of infirmity are a resplendent sign that "God has visited his people" and that the Kingdom of God is close at hand. Jesus has the power not only to heal, but also to forgive sins; he has come to heal the whole man, soul and body; he is the physician the sick have need of. His compassion toward all who suffer goes so far that he identifies himself with them: "I was sick and you visited me." His preferential love for the sick has not ceased through the centuries to draw the very special attention of Christians toward all those who

suffer in body and soul. It is the source of tireless efforts to comfort them.

Since Jesus has such love for those who suffer, we as Catholics should also have the same love.

On Thursday, July 21 at 6:30 pm at St. Augustine's, we will gather to pray with and for one another. This may be a bit daunting for some people. It may be a new experience. All people have certain things weighing on their hearts, and it is good for us to allow these intentions to be offered up with other Christians. We do not need to carry our crosses alone. You may want to ask for prayer for something you are struggling with personally, or you may want to pray for someone else. There will be an opportunity for people to approach different prayer stations where you will be asked, "How can we pray for you tonight?" After you share, you can simply remain silent, calling upon the Holy Spirit in prayer. In praying with and for one another, we do come to know the grace of God and healing power of Jesus in our day.

I hope you will prayerfully consider being a part of this evening. We will also adore Jesus in the Eucharist. It will be an opportunity to give Him thanks and praise. It should be a wonderful night.

May the peace of the Lord be with you always.


