#### A MESSAGE FROM OUR SHEPHERD

ast summer, in August of ■ 2021, I had a couple vacation days. I spent these days with my parents. We went to the Brainerd area for a day and then spent a day in Walker. I always enjoy spending time with my parents. I celebrated Mass each of these days, as I do every day, and my parents joined me. As I was concluding the celebration of the Mass in Walker, I asked my dad to consider joining the program where individuals discern becoming Catholic. As many of you know, my dad was not Catholic at this point and became Catholic last Easter.

Over the years, he attended more Masses and other Catholic events as I made my way through seminary and priesthood. At Mass, he would do his best to follow along. After the Mass in Walker, I felt an interior nudge, the Holy Spirit, prompting me to ask my dad to consider this program. In relation to family, reaching out in this way can be daunting because we fear rejection or isolating them even more by being too pushy. In that moment though, it felt right, so I asked him. He thought about it for awhile. Then he said, "Yes". Then he attended the various sessions to be informed about Catholicism. Ultimately he decided to become Catholic... and I continue to give thanks to God!

Our Catholic faith is our greatest gift. Though we have a lot in common with our other Christian brothers and sisters, we do have our differences. There are over 40,000 Christian denominations. We believe that the Catholic Church is the true Church that Jesus founded and that He continues to safeguard His Church through the Holy Spirit throughout the generations.

Though the Church is made up of sinners, we believe it is holy because of God. The Catholic Church is home to all people, whether they realize it or not. Catholic means universal.

The Salvation of Christ is for all. Our role as Catholics is to help all people to experience this eternal gift and to live within God's Church, our truest home.

We will be starting the program again this fall where people can discern the possibility of becoming Catholic. This program has been called RCIA, the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. The name is changing to OCIA, the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults. Whether we refer to the program as RCIA or OCIA, we are referring to the same program.

I encourage you to pray about people you could ask to join this program. Some people may appreciate an invitation. Ask the Holy Spirit to place certain individuals on your heart... maybe it is someone from work or school or from another activity. Or possibly even family. Then ask them. Be not afraid! They may say "no" but at least you planted a seed.

If you know someone who is interested, please share contact information with me or the deacons and we will share details with them about the process.

May the peace of the Lord be with you always.






