

A MESSAGE FROM OUR SHEPHERD

hen we gather for the celebration of the Holy Mass, we gather around the altar. Altars are traditionally places of sacrifice. At Mass, the perfect sacrifice of Jesus is recalled and represented. Jesus gave His life so that we may have life. The life-giving Passion, death and resurrection of Jesus is made accessible in sacred mystery through the celebration of the Mass. When we gather for the Mass, around the altar of the Lord, we should be inspired to live sacrificially like Jesus and receive the grace to lay down our lives like Him.

Another name for the altar is the Lord's table. Through baptism, we become children of God. As children of God, we are also brothers and sisters in the Lord. It is at the Lord's table that we are nourished with the body and blood of Christ. We also listen to the Word of God at Mass, so that we may know how to live our lives in a way that is pleasing to the Lord, to our Father in Heaven. We become Who we receive. When we come together at Mass, we realize that we unite as God's family, in Communion with Heaven and earth. We are united in the power of the Holy Spirit, in giving of ourselves in imitation of our Savior. We offer our lives in union with the perfect offering of Jesus.

I now shift this theological reflection to a more practical reflection. Knowing what we know about our Faith, in relation to what I mentioned above, we should be grateful to be a member of God's family. We should be grateful to be a member of the household of God. Responsibilities also come with this membership. Another way of looking at these responsibilities would be as opportunities to serve, to lay down our lives. If we neglect the responsibilities of our earthly homes, we know that our earthly homes will begin to deteriorate, and this neglect can have an adverse effect in relation to the members of the household. Same with our spiritual home, the Church. When you walk into church, I hope you feel as though it is your home. It truly is! With this truth in mind, we are all responsible for the upkeep of our home. It involves sacrifice, but what a blessing it is to cooperate with the upkeep of God's House! What a blessing for ourselves and others!

I am in the process of recruiting buildings & grounds members for our churches. for St. Joe's and St. Augustine's. These committees only meet a few times a year or as needed. People have a variety of skills in the trades, and our churches could benefit from a variety of perspectives. We want to make sure we keep up with the necessary maintenance of our church buildings and properties. 


