A few ways we strive to reach out: (1) Parishioners deliver bulletins to our communities assisted living and nursing homes, (2) Our parish mails the bulletin to 28 households, (3) Fr. and parishioners visit residences and homes w/ Communion and rosary (this has been more difficult/hindered during the pandemic – striving to improve and grow this), (4) Parish Outreach Teams continue to meet, send cards, make phone calls, and (5) Mercy Tour Group is beginning to meet to find ways to serve those in our community most in need, (6) Parish Family Rosary is a way we pray for every one of our 'Church.' O Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us, and make our hearts like Thine.
