We often refer to and talk about the "Church." We might think of the Church building. We say, "I go to Church on Sunday's," or, "I am on my way to Church." On Ash Wednesday I was able to visit 'the Church' at Heritage Manor to bring them ashes. Not only was there a service in 'the park,' but I visited many rooms. Then on March 4th, the 1st Friday of Lent, I was able to visit 'the Church' during home visits. I was struck and reminded that 'our Church' is not so much our building but 'us,' the people. This Lent I want to strengthen my commitment and all of our commitment to reach those who are unable to come to our 'church' buildings. A few ways we strive to reach out: (1) Parishioners deliver bulletins to our communities assisted living and nursing homes, (2) Our parish mails the bulletin to 28 households, (3) Fr. and parishioners visit residences and homes w/ Communion and rosary (this has been more difficult/hindered during the pandemic – striving to improve and grow this), (4) Parish Outreach Teams continue to meet, send cards, make phone calls, and (5) Mercy Tour Group is beginning to meet to find ways to serve those in our community most in need, (6) Parish Family Rosary is a way we pray for every one of our 'Church.' **O Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us, and make our hearts like Thine.**
