**Collection For The Church In  
Central and Eastern Europe**



Major Archbishop Sviatoslav Shevchuk of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church in Kyiv has appealed to the Christian faithful of the world asking prayers for the peace and safety of the Ukrainian people. He has reminded us to place hope in Christ.

The Church in Ukraine is persevering in hope even amidst the violence. Though curfews keep the faithful from gathering in churches, "the Church will come to the people" by continuing to celebrate liturgy and provide the Sacraments in bomb shelters and underground stations.

Pope Francis has called upon the Universal Church to **pray and fast** especially for peace in Ukraine. Catholics in the US can also show their solidarity by participating this Collection for the Church in Central Eastern Europe. The collection will help the Church in Ukraine bring the light of Christ to the faithful affected by the darkness of war, violence, and loss of families and homes and provide other essential funding in the region.

This weekend of **March 19-20**, honoring St. Joseph as the patron of exiles and the afflicted, **parishes of the Diocese of Duluth** are taken up the collection for victims of the war in Ukraine and the resulting humanitarian crisis. In particular, this USCCB Collection for the Church in Central and Eastern Europe **will provide assistance to the victims of the war as well as other projects the collection supports in the region, such as training seminarians and lay leaders, supporting social service programs, youth ministry, pastoral and catechetical centers, schools, church construction and renovation, and evangelization through Catholic media.**
