***St. Joseph's Facility Assessment Feasibility/Planning Study Announced***

One of our goals is to secure, sustain, and grow the ministries that serve our children, youth, and adults now and for generations to come. To accomplish that we must have safe, comfortable, and well-maintained facilities to support our worship, education, fellowship, and outreach activities.

Over the past several weeks, we have gathered important information to share with all parishioners during four identical presentation/dialogue meetings scheduled for:

- Sunday afternoon April 24 4:00 p.m. – 5:45 p.m. St. Joseph Social Hall in Chisholm
- Monday afternoon April 25 1:00 p.m. – 2:45 p.m. St. Joseph Social Hall in Chisholm
- Monday evening April 25 6:30 p.m. – 8:15 p.m. St. Joseph Social Hall in Chisholm
- Tuesday morning April 26 8:45 a.m. – 10:30 a.m. Our Lady of the Sacred Heart in Buhl

During these identical meetings, we will review and discuss our parish mission, history, demographics, volunteer leadership, programs/ministries, outreach, finances, the history of our facility planning efforts, summary of the facility assessment study, proposed repairs and improvements, contractor tested cost estimates, the features/benefits we could achieve by completing the proposed projects, guiding principles for a potential capital campaign, and the next steps in the process.

We intend to provide you with the best information we currently have available, and will solicit your comments, questions, and constructive ideas about the proposal. The process we are using to present the information and solicit your feedback is called a Feasibility/Planning Study which will include four parish meetings, personal interviews, and written surveys from those who choose to attend. The study will be directed by Hal Johnson and Associates of Bloomington, a church development consultant with 48 years of experience working with 320 churches.

As a valued parishioner, your response to the information you receive through this Feasibility/Planning Study will help guide our next steps. Therefore, your participation is not only welcome, but it is essential to create a forward-thinking and fiscally responsible plan for our facilities. At each meeting, childcare will be provided for those who need it, and refreshments will also be served.

Throughout our history, the time, talent, and treasure of hard-working volunteers, staff and parishioners have accomplished many great things in our parish. Now we have the privilege and responsibility of shaping how we might provide repaired and improved facilities for this generation and those who will join us in the future.

God has entrusted us with this important task, so let's fully embrace it. Stay tuned for more information in the weeks to come. Thank you!
