**The Office of Tenebrae (which means "darkness" or "shadows") is a Holy Week devotion which dates back to the seventh or eight century A.D. and is characterized by the successive extinguishing of candles as the service progresses. No service during the entire church year is more biblical; every word of Tenebrae is taken verbatim from the Scriptures. It concludes with Psalm 51. Then the Christ Candle is removed for a time, symbolizing our Lord's death and burial. The strepitus is heard, a harsh noise indicating the closing of the tomb. Then the Christ Candle is returned in anticipation of our Lord's resurrection. All then leave in silence.
