**PALM SUNDAY

***The Office of Tenebrae (which means "darkness" or "shadows") is a Holy Week devotion which dates back to the seventh or eighth century A.D. and is characterized by the successive extinguishing of candles as the service progresses. No service during the entire church year is more biblical; every word of Tenebrae is taken verbatim from the Scriptures. It concludes with Psalm 51. Then the Christ Candle is removed for a time, symbolizing our Lord's death and burial. The strepitus is heard, a harsh noise indicating the closing of the tomb. Then the Christ Candle is returned in anticipation of our Lord's resurrection. All then leave in silence.*

We will need a **full crew on Tuesday 9 am** to dust and spit shine the Church for Easter. Bring your dusting stuff. The burnishing creates some dust. No way to get away from that.

This has been a great effort and it shows. Thank you to all. If you know people to invite for Tuesday, please do so. This will be a show piece for our Easter participants and a wonderful tribute to our Lord as we celebrate his passion and resurrection.
