O SACRAMENT MOST HOLY (Bulletin Series on the Eucharist)

Sunday June 19, 2022 will begin the National Eucharistic Revival in the United States. It will begin a three-year effort to revive and grow in our devotion to the Most Holy Sacrament, the source and summit of our life, the flesh of Jesus given for the life of the world. In this bulletin I invite us to ponder objects, gestures, and behaviors as they relate to the Eucharist.

ALTAR, The heart of every Catholic Church, where Jesus is made present, on which the Sacrifice of Christ on Calvary is renewed, the place heaven and earth meet. Usually made of stone. One or more relics of martyrs are commonly set into the altar. Should be consecrated by the rites provided in the Roman Pontifical.

BELLS, MASS rung during the Eucharistic Prayer (see below) one time at the Epiclesis (see below) and three times at the showing of the Sacred Host and Chalice to direct the attention of the congregation to this most solemn part of the Mass.

BREAD, of WHEAT is associated with being sown, fallen, crushed, and buried, but then springing up for bread to feed multitudes. These are all symbols of Christ's passion, death, resurrection, and communion with his Church in the Sacrifice of the Mass.

CHALICE, Set apart for use in the Mass to contain the wine which becomes the Precious Blood of Christ.

CONSECRATION, The words of institution of the Eucharist, pronounced at Mass, by which is accomplished the very sacrifice that Christ instituted at the Last Supper. The formula of consecration is uniform for all the approved canons of the Mass.

CORPORAL, The square white linen cloth on which the Host and Chalice are placed during Mass. Symbolic of the burial clothes around Our Lord when he was buried in the tomb.

EPICLESIS, The invocation of the Holy Spirit said by the celebrant of the Mass and symbolized by the gesture of holding his hands extended over the offerings and ring of the mass bells.

EUCCHARISTIC FAST, The abstinence from food and drink for one hour before receiving Holy Communion. Originally this meant complete abstinence even from water and medicine from midnight. Pope Pius XII in 1953 modified the fast by giving permission for liquids (except alcohol) up to one hour before Communion. Pope Paul VI in 1964 further reduced the precept allowing water and medicine to be taken any time up to reception of the Sacrament.

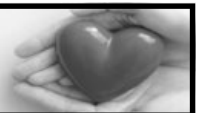
