## THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD MAY 29, 2022

**SACRAMENT MOST HOLY:** Part 2 (Ongoing Bulletin Series on the Eucharist) Sunday June 19, 2022 will begin the National Eucharistic Revival in the United States. It will begin a three-year effort to revive and grow in our devotion to the Most Holy Sacrament, the source and summit of our life, the flesh of Jesus given for the life of the world. This week I invite us to further ponder objects, gestures, and behaviors as they relate to the Eucharist.

**EUCHARIST PRAYER**, the heart and center of the Eucharistic liturgy. Spoken by the priest. Pronouncing these words, he 'acts in the person' of Christ. Begins with the Preface dialogue and the Sanctus (Holy, holy, holy...). All then kneel. Followed by the Epiclesis, Consecration, and Doxology. Its ritual history goes back to apostolic times. Today there are several Eucharist Prayers listed in the Roman Missal, but three or four are most commonly used, namely Eucharist Prayer I, II, & III (more rarely IV).

**GENUFLECTION,** bending of the knee as an act of reverence. Customary when passing before the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle, entering the pew for divine worship, and during certain ceremonies to the Cross (i.e. Good Friday). Genuflections are also made to the Pope, to a cardinal, and to a bishop in his own diocese.

PRECEPTS of the CATHOLIC CHURCH, Certain commandments prescribed for observance by all Catholics. A sort of "bare minimum" expected of every Catholic Christian. Included here are the first two:

- 1. To keep holy the day of the Lord's Resurrection: to worship God by participating in Mass every Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation: to avoid those activities that would hinder renewal of soul and body, e.g., needless work and business activities, unnecessary shopping, etc.
- 2. To lead a sacramental life: to receive Holy Communion frequently and the Sacrament of Penance regularly. minimally, to receive the Sacrament of Penance at least once a year.
- minimally, to receive Holy Communion at least once a year.

**PURIFICATER**, white cloth used to purify the chalice, paten, and fingers after distributing Holy Communion. **REAL PRESENCE**, the manner of Christ's presence in the Holy Eucharist. The Council of Trent declared that "in the sacrament of the most holy Holy Eucharist is contained truly, really, and substantially the body and blood, together with the soul and divinity, of our Lord Jesus Christ."

**ROMAN MISSAL**, the large red book containing the prayers recited by the priest at the altar and from the chair during Mass.

We will be ordering the 2023 book later this summer.




