

Fr. Rich's Ramblings


One of the bigger challenges St. James has had for awhile was the lack of a real "cry room" for fussy young ones. Before the sanctuary remodel we had the cry room up along side the sanctuary but from my perspective it was just a bit odd to have people right up in the sanctuary looking in from the side, and from the families perspective I have often heard the phrase "the walk of shame" having to walk all the way up to the front of the church with a crying baby. It just was not a good placement for something as necessary as a place to go with fussy children.

Needless to say I am happy that we now have a great solution for the problem; we have been working on the 57th entrance for months now and we still are not done, but we are done with the fact that it is now a completely functioning cry room. If you do not normally go through that entrance I would encourage you to check it out. It is much brighter with new ceiling and lighting and the back wall is now all windows. The doors coming into the nave of the church will soon be replaced with glass doors as well so that there will be a great view of the sanctuary. We also have the sound pumped into the room so that you will not only be able to see the Mass but also hear it.. In other words it is now a perfectly functioning cry room without the "walk of shame" to the front.

Our parish is growing and has more and more young families which is the greatest thing a parish can ever hope for, but with that also comes the sometimes interruption of the uncontrollable baby, and I am not talking about Deacon Lyle. I want to encourage all of our parishioners who have young ones to take advantage of the cry room; that when your baby or toddlers start to act up, please bring them to the part of the church designed for such occasions. We did this remodel with this very much in mind and want to encourage its use. The whole narthex remodel will not be done for a few more months, but it is already way better than what it was. Another exciting transformation to our parish.

Gospel Meditation

In his Apostolic Exhortation, The Joy of the Gospel, Pope Francis references a thought from Pope Benedict XVI: "Being a Christian is not the result of an ethical choice or a lofty idea, but the encounter with an event, a person, which gives life a new horizon and a decisive direction." Today we celebrate an encounter with the Person of Jesus Christ! This simple but holy event in time dramatically changes human life, pointing it toward a new horizon and giving it a decisive direction. This is a message and truth that is not meant to be shared with only a select few who qualify but with the entire world. Pope Francis continues saying, "Thanks

solely to this encounter or renewed encounter with God's love, which blossoms into an enriching friendship, we are liberated from our narrowness and self-absorption. We become fully human when we become more than human, when we let God bring us beyond ourselves in order to attain the fullest truth of our being."

Look around at people. Where is life heading for them? What gives them direction? Even



we who are people of faith can get distracted and lose our focus. God, in all of His fullness, is revealed in Jesus Christ and we can encounter Him! God is tangible, real, vulnerable, poor, and full of wonders, surprises, and opportunities. For those who are struggling and lost, today is a day of great joy. All they have to do is reach out and touch the truth of Christ. This presence is revealed in the poor, exploited, and vulnerable ones who cry out for compassion and love. But it is also found in the faithful ones who see in the Epiphany of God a liberation from structures and systems that hurt us, a narrowness of mind and heart that constricts us, and an absorption in our self-agenda that prevents us from seeing anything other than ourselves as important.

We have been given the charge of preaching this Good News. If only we could find a way to be more effective, it might stand a chance of doing what God intended it to do. There is always tomorrow and our memory of that bright new light that shone so brilliantly that Bethlehem night pointing us to truth and reminding us that we are loved.


