Dear Parishioners,

Christmas ends with the Lord's Baptism. Jesus accepts baptism and the Holy Spirit reveals Jesus as the 'beloved Son' of the Father. This leads directly to his mission of proclaiming the kingdom of God and the forgiveness of sin: Jesus saves all. It's a wonderful way to end the Christmas season.

We also celebrate the confirmation of Gerald Whitaker at the 10 am Mass. Gerald's discernment has been a progress of faith. We welcome him and, as a parish faith community, we offer our prayers and Christian example to guide him. Gerald shares with us that he joined the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) in 2018 but work obligations interfered. He says: "I rejoined RCIA classes at first because it was important to my wife...After a couple months it became important to me as well and I decided to be confirmed Catholic...I came to realize it's not how much you know about the Catholic faith that make you Catholic, but it's how you feel and the life you try to live."

Living the Catholic faith is important. St James reminds us that a Christian is a person of faith and good works. The good we do is based on the faith we hold; Gerald's experience can help us understand our practice of faith. We support Gerald with prayer and our good example of Christian life. Welcome Gerald to St. Alphonsus – God's grace be with you always.

May God, who has begun good work in you, bring it to fulfillment before the day of Christ Jesus.


