

Dear Parishioners,

How appropriate it is that we revisit this weekend the first chapter of Luke's Gospel, as we are at the beginning of the liturgical calendar. We hear from Luke of how Jesus begins his ministry after being baptized by John in the Jordan. Jesus teaches in the synagogue and reads the words of the prophet Isaiah. These words foreshadow very well what Jesus would do in his ministry.

He would anoint, he would preach to the poor and oppressed, and would praise the Father will all his good works. Most important is what Jesus says at the end of the Gospel passage, "Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing." Jesus is speaking about himself, as he is the living Word. Isaiah's words are fulfilled in Jesus, as the New Testament is the fulfillment of the Old Testament.

The words of Isaiah and Luke invite us to pay attention to what we will hear in the Gospel passages within the upcoming weeks of Ordinary Time. Let us recognize how all the attributes of Jesus described in Luke's Gospel are fulfilled in Jesus. This will help us to develop our understanding of who Jesus was during his time and who Jesus is for us in our spiritual life.

Escuchamos de Lucas cómo Jesús comienza su ministerio después de ser bautizado por Juan en el Jordán. Jesús enseña en la sinagoga y lee las palabras del profeta Isaías. Estas palabras presagian muy bien lo que Jesús haría en su ministerio.

Ungiría, predicaría a los pobres y oprimidos, y alabaría su Padre por todas sus buenas obras. Lo más importante es lo que Jesús dice al final del pasaje del Evangelio: "Hoy se cumple este pasaje de la Escritura en presencia de ustedes."
