

Dear Parishioners,

"The word of the Lord came to me" (Jeremiah 1:4)

Having assured him of his prophetic call, God prepares Jeremiah for the fate that lies ahead of him. Jeremiah is told to get ready for some ordeal, and the test is the proclamation of the word of the Lord. It is not going to be an easy task. Love for God and for God's word would lead Jeremiah to accept a mission he did not choose. This mission would require Jeremiah to speak out boldly and relentlessly for God. The Lord tells Jeremiah not to fear because "the word of the Lord" will protect him against his adversaries.

Love for God and for God's people would also lead Jesus to persevere in proclaiming a Gospel that was often regarded as an unpopular challenge by unwilling listeners. Love led Jesus to suffer rejection, personal injury, loneliness, and even death for the sake of the mission he had come to fulfill. As is reflected in the Gospel reading this week, love led Jesus to dare to proclaim the fulfillment of Isaiah's presence in his hometown synagogue. Jesus proclaims glad tidings of freedom for captives, for the oppressed, and restore sight to the blind (Lk. 4:18-19). Hearing these words challenges the people to do what they hear, and for this, they reject Jesus and want to destroy him. Yet God, whose word Jesus speaks, delivers him as he "passed through the midst of them."

The word of God led Jeremiah to a life of experiences that would test his faith. Jesus' rejection by the people of Nazareth reminds those who speak God's words that they may expect to receive anger and rejection at the hands of those to whom they speak. Like Jesus, we should not be discouraged from proclaiming the Good News. The details of our daily living must assure others that the words we proclaim are, indeed, from God. Because our proclamation comes from the Spirit who dwells within us, therefore, we need not be afraid.

Estimados feligreses

"La palabra del Señor vino a mí" (Jeremías 1:4)

Habiéndole asegurado su llamado profético, Dios prepara a Jeremías para el destino que le espera. Se le dice a Jeremías que se prepare para una prueba, y la prueba es la proclamación de la palabra del Señor. No va a ser una tarea fácil. El amor a Dios ya la palabra de Dios llevaría a Jeremías a aceptar una misión que no eligió. Esta misión requeriría que Jeremías hablara con valentía e implacablemente por Dios. El Señor le dice a Jeremías que no tema porque "la palabra del Señor" lo protegerá contra sus adversarios.

El amor por Dios y por el pueblo de Dios también llevaría a Jesús a perseverar en la proclamación de un Evangelio que a menudo era considerado como un desafío impopular por los oyentes reacios. El amor llevó a Jesús a sufrir el rechazo, los daños personales, la soledad y hasta la muerte por causa de la misión que había venido a cumplir. Como se refleja en la lectura del Evangelio de esta semana, el amor llevó a Jesús a atreverse a proclamar el cumplimiento de la presencia de Isaías en la sinagoga de su ciudad natal. Jesús anuncia la buena noticia de la libertad de los cautivos, de los oprimidos y de la vista a los ciegos (Lc 4, 18-19). Escuchar estas palabras desafía a la gente a hacer lo que escuchan, y por eso rechazan a Jesús y quieren destruirlo. Sin embargo, Dios, cuya palabra pronuncia Jesús, lo libera cuando "pasó por en medio de ellos".

La palabra de Dios llevó a Jeremías a una vida de experiencias que probarían su fe. El rechazo de Jesús por parte de la gente de Nazaret les recuerda a aquellos que hablan las palabras de Dios qué pueden esperar recibir ira y rechazo de manos de aquellos a quienes les hablan. Como Jesús, no debemos desanimarnos de proclamar la Buena Nueva. Los detalles de nuestra vida diaria deben asegurar a los demás que las palabras que proclamamos son, en verdad, de Dios. Debido a que nuestra proclamación proviene del Espíritu que mora en nosotros, por lo tanto, no debemos tener miedo.
