How far are you willing to go for your faith? This is a question that we often hear in our world today, and the answers to this question vary tremendously depending on the particular faith of the person answering the question. For us as a Christian community, the scriptures this weekend provide us with significant examples of faith. The letter to the Hebrews reminds us of how Abraham, following God's will, journeyed into an unknown land to receive his inheritance and ascended a mountain to sacrifice his son, Isaac. In both situations, Abraham did God's will without knowing where it would lead him or what was going to happen. Moving along to the Gospel, we encounter the servant who was ignorant but still did his master's will. Eventually, he received a less severe beating than the servant who did not do the master's will.

Brothers and sisters, these examples of faith in scripture show us that God blesses those who follow God's will no matter what, and God blesses them in the end. Many of us, including myself, may think of the moments, when we tried our best to do God's will regardless of what will happen but in the end, we don't feel that we are blessed. In these moments, we are invited to pray. We can ask God to increase our faith, so that we have the patience and belief that God's blessing will eventually come in God's accordance and time. It may be in the moment or in the way that we least expect God's blessing. I believe that just having the faith to pray, when one feels hopeless is a blessing from God in itself.

¿Hasta dónde estás dispuesto a llegar por tu fe? Esta es una pregunta que escuchamos muchas veces en nuestro mundo de hoy, y las respuestas a esta pregunta varían enormemente dependiendo de la fe particular de la persona que contesta la pregunta. Para nosotros como una comunidad cristiana, las escrituras de este fin de semana nos brindan ejemplos significativos de fe. La carta a los Hebreos nos recuerda cómo Abraham, siguiendo la voluntad de Dios, viajó a una tierra desconocida para recibir su herencia y subió a una montaña para sacrificar a su hijo Isaac. En ambas situaciones, Abraham hizo la voluntad de Dios sin saber a dónde lo llevaría o qué iba a pasar. Avanzando hacia el Evangelio, nos encontramos con el siervo que era ignorante pero aún hizo la voluntad de su amo. Eventualmente, recibió una paliza menos severa que el siervo que no hizo la voluntad del amo.

Hermanos y hermanas, estos ejemplos de fe en las Escrituras nos muestran que Dios bendice a aquellos que siguen la voluntad de Dios sin importar qué, y Dios los bendice al final. Muchos de nosotros, incluyéndome a mí, podemos pensar en los momentos en los que hicimos todo lo posible para hacer la voluntad de Dios, independientemente de lo que suceda, pero al final, no nos sentimos bendecidos. En estos momentos, estamos invitados a orar. Podemos pedirle a Dios que aumente nuestra fe, para que tengamos la paciencia y la creencia de que la bendición de Dios eventualmente llegará en el tiempo y la conformidad de Dios. Puede ser en el momento o en la forma en que menos esperamos la bendición de Dios. Creo que el solo hecho de tener fe para orar, cuando una persona se siente desesperanzado, es una bendición de Dios en sí misma.

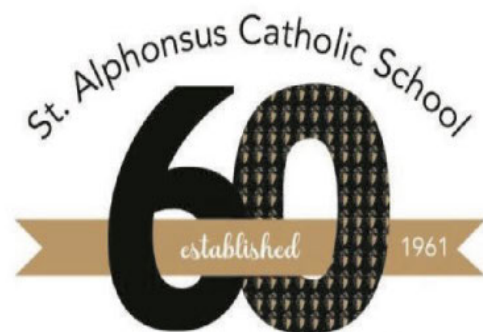

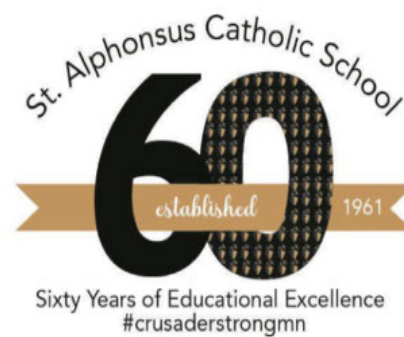
