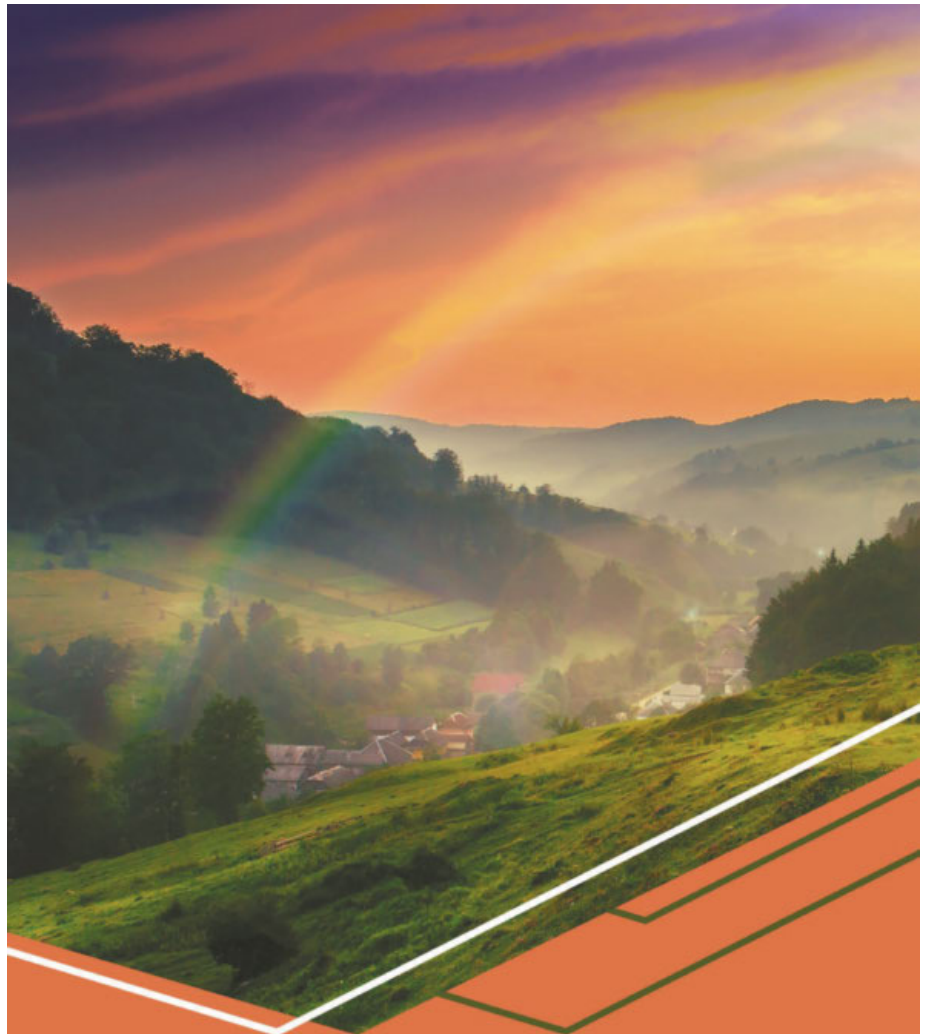

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday, August 28, we will welcome Bishop Joseph Williams to St. Alphonsus. He will preside at the 10:00 a.m. Mass in honor of the schools' 60th anniversary. We are a year late, but I feel we are celebrating a significant achievement over the 60+ years. Catholic education is an important aspect of the U.S. Catholic Church. In the early days, Catholics banded together to support each other in a new and often hostile social environment. Immigrants felt this anxiety especially as they worked to establish themselves in a new county with different customs and languages. The parish and its school were an important way to educate children in a new place, develop their understanding of their faith, offer support and encouragement, and prepare them to contribute to their community.

Redemptorists have ministered in immigrant communities since the first days when we arrived in the U.S. in 1832. Parishes such as St. Peter's in Philadelphia, St. Philomena in Pittsburg, St. Mary in New Orleans, St. Michael in Chicago all served the immigrant people with a Catholic education. In some places, such as New Orleans, a Catholic school still reaches out to the children of the neighborhood even though most of the students are not Catholic. The presence of the Church is a great blessing, and we see this in Catholic education.

As we celebrate our parish school, we realize that its mission hasn't changed but its audience has. We are a stable presence in our neighborhood. Our teachers are dedicated to helping our students excel in a supportive and excellent academic environment. We are guided by Catholic values, and we pass on these values by our word and example.

Please come to the Mass on Sunday to welcome Bishop Williams and to celebrate the gift Catholic education is to St. Alphonsus. After Mass all are invited to a reception and tour of the school. Come and meet the family of St. Alphonsus Parish School.

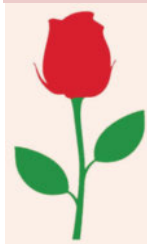

Este fin de semana, 28 de agosto, daremos la bienvenida al obispo Joseph Williams a St. Alphonsus. Oficiará la misa de 10:00a.m. en honor al 60 aniversario de la escuela. Estamos un año tarde, pero siento que estamos celebrando un logro significativo durante los más de 60 años.

La educación católica es un aspecto importante de la Iglesia Católica de los Estados Unidos. En los primeros días, los católicos se unían para apoyarse unos a otros en un entorno social nuevo y por lo regular, hostil. Los inmigrantes sentían esta ansiedad especialmente cuando trabajaban para establecerse en un nuevo condado con diferentes costumbres y lenguajes. La parroquia y su escuela fueron una forma importante de educar a los niños en un nuevo lugar, desarrollar el entendimiento de su fe, ofrecer apoyo y aliento, y prepararlos para contribuir a su comunidad.

Los redentoristas han ministrado en comunidades de inmigrantes desde los primeros días cuando llegamos a los Estados Unidos en 1832. Parroquias como St. Peter's en Filadelfia, St. Philomena en Pittsburg, St. Mary en New Orleans, St. Michael en Chicago, todas sirvieron a los inmigrantes. Personas con educación católica. En algunos lugares, como New Orleans, la escuela católica aún se acerca a los niños del vecindario a pesar de que la mayoría de los estudiantes no son católicos. La presencia de la Iglesia es una gran bendición y lo vemos en la educación Católica.

Mientras celebramos nuestra Escuela de la Parroquia nos damos cuenta de que su misión no ha cambiado, pero su público sí. Somos una presencia estable en nuestro vecindario. Nuestros maestros están dedicados a ayudar a nuestros estudiantes a sobresalir en un entorno académico excelente y de apoyo. Nos guiamos por valores Católicos, y pasamos estos valores con nuestra palabra y ejemplo.

Venga a Misa del domingo para dar la bienvenida al obispo Williams y para celebrar el regalo que la educación católica es para St. Alphonsus. Después de Misa, todos están invitados a una recepción y un recorrido por la escuela. Venga y conozca a la familia de la escuela Parroquial de St. Alphonsus.

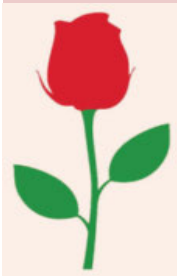
