FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The Life of Jesus

1.—The Annunciation / Incarnation; Luke 1:26-38. The angel said to Mary, "Behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name him Jesus."

2.—The Visitation of Mary to Elizabeth; Luke 1:39-56. When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the infant, John the Baptist, leapt in her womb.

3.—The Nativity / Birth of Jesus; Luke 2:1-19. While they were in Bethlehem, the time came for Mary to have her child, and she gave birth to her firstborn son, Jesus.

4.—The Presentation of the baby Jesus; Luke 2:22-40. Joseph and Mary took Jesus up to the Temple in Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord.

5.—The Finding of Jesus in the Temple; Luke 2:41-52. Jesus said to Mary and Joseph, "Why were you looking for me? Did you not know that I must be in my Father's house?"

6.—The Baptism of Jesus; Matthew 3:13-17. When Jesus was baptized, a voice came from the heavens, saying, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."

7.—The Miracle at the Wedding at Cana; John 2:1-11. Mary, the mother of Jesus, said to the servers, "Do whatever He tells you."

8.—The Proclamation of the Kingdom of God; Matthew 4:17 & 5:1-16. Jesus began to preach and say, "Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand."

9.—The Transfiguration; Luke 9:28-36. While Jesus was praying, His face changed in appearance and His clothing became dazzling white.

10.—The Eucharist / Last Supper; Luke 22:7-23. Then Jesus took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my Body, which will be given for you; do this in memory of Me."

11.—The Prayer and Agony in the Garden; Luke 22:39-46. Jesus prayed, "Father, if You are willing, take this cup away from me, still, not My Will, but Yours be done."

12.—The Scourging at the Pillar; Mark 15:15. So Pontius Pilate, after he had Jesus scourged, handed Him over to be crucified.

13.—The Crowning with Thorns; John 18:36-38 & 19:1-5. The soldiers wove a crown out of thorns and placed it on Jesus' head, and clothed Him in a purple cloak.

14.—The Carrying of the Cross; John 19:16-17. They took Jesus, and carrying the cross Himself He went out to what is called the Place of the Skull.

15.—The Crucifixion and Death of Jesus; John 19:16-37. Jesus said, "It is finished." And bowing His head, He handed over the Spirit.

16.—The Resurrection of Jesus; Luke 24:1-8. The angels said to the women, "Why do you seek the living among the dead? Jesus is not here. He has been raised!"

17.—The Ascension of Jesus to Heaven; Matthew 28:16-20. Jesus said, "Behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age."

18.—The Pentecost / Descent of the Holy Spirit; Acts 2:1-13. While Mary, the Apostles and the disciples were praying, there appeared to them tongues as of fire, and they were filled with the Holy Spirit.

19.—The Assumption of Mary into Heaven; Dogma declared by the Catholic Church which states, "The Immaculate Mother of God, the Virgin Mary, after completing her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory."

20.—The Coronation of Mary; Tradition of the Catholic Church, based on Revelation (12:1), A great sign appeared in the sky, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars.

- 1.—**La Anunciación** / Encarnación; Lucas 1, 26-38.
El ángel le dijo a María, "He aquí, concebirás en tu vientre y darás a luz un hijo, y lo llamarás Jesús".
- 2.—**La Visitación** de María a Isabel; Lucas 1, 39-56.
Cuando Isabel escuchó el saludo de María, el bebé, Juan el Bautista, saltó en su vientre.
- 3.—**La Natividad** / Nacimiento de Jesús; Lucas 2, 1-19. Mientras estaban en Belén, llegó el tiempo del parto, y María dio a luz a su hijo primogénito, Jesús.
- 4.—**La Presentación** del niño Jesús; Lucas 2, 22-40. José y María llevaron a Jesús al Templo en Jerusalén para presentarlo al Señor.
- 5.—**El Hallazgo** de Jesús en el Templo; Lucas 2, 41-52. Jesús le dijo a María y a José, "¿Y por qué me buscaban? ¿No saben que yo debo estar en la casa de mi Padre?"
- 6.—**El Bautismo** de Jesús; Mateo 3, 13-17. Cuando Jesús fue bautizado, se oyó una voz del Cielo que decía: "Este es mi Hijo amado, con quien estoy muy complacido".
- 7.—**El Milagro** en la Boda de Caná; Juan 2, 1-11. María, la madre de Jesús, dijo a los sirvientes, "Hagan lo que Él les diga."
- 8.—**La Proclamación** del Reino de Dios; Mateo 4, 17 y 5, 1-16. Jesús empezó a predicar y proclamar, "Arrepiéntanse, porque el Reino de los Cielos está cerca".
- 9.—**La Transfiguración**; Lucas 9, 28-36. Mientras Jesús estaba orando, su cara cambió de aspecto y su ropa se volvió de una blancura fulgurante.
- 10.—**La Eucaristía** / Última Cena; Lucas 22, 7-23. Después Jesús tomó pan, y dando gracias, lo partió y se los dio diciendo, "Esto es mi cuerpo, que es entregado por ustedes; hagan esto en memoria mía."
- 11.—**La Oración** y Agonía en el Huerto; Lucas 22, 39-46. Jesús rezo, "Padre, si Tú quieres, aparta de mi esta copa, pero, no se haga mi voluntad, sino la tuya."
- 12.—**La Flagelación** en la Columna; Marcos 15, 15. Pilato, entonces, entregó a Jesús, después de azotarlo, para que fuera crucificado."
- 13.—**La Coronación** de Espinas; Juan 18, 36-38 y 19, 1-5. Los soldados hicieron una corona de espinas y se la pusieron en la cabeza de Jesús, y lo vistieron con una capa morada.
- 14.—**La Carga** de la Cruz; Juan 19, 16-17. Tomaron a Jesús, y cargando su propia cruz, salió de la ciudad hacia el lugar llamado Calvario.
- 15.—**La Crucifixión** y Muerte de Jesús; Juan 19, 16-37. Jesús dijo, "Todo está cumplido." Después inclino la cabeza y entregó el Espíritu.
- 16.—**La Resurrección** de Jesús; Lucas 24, 1-8. Los ángeles le dijeron a las mujeres: "¿Por qué buscan entre los muertos al que vive? Jesús no está aquí. ¡Resucitó!"
- 17.—**La Ascensión** de Jesús al Cielo; Mateo 28, 16-20. Jesús les dijo: "Yo estoy con ustedes todos los días hasta el fin de la historia.
- 18.—**El Pentecostés** / La Venida del Espíritu Santo; Hechos 2, 1-13. Mientras María, los Apóstoles y los discípulos rezaban, se les aparecieron lenguas de fuego y fueron llenos del Espíritu Santo.
- 19.—**La Asunción** de María al Cielo; Doctrina declarada por la Iglesia Católica, que establece: 'La Inmaculada Madre de Dios, la Virgen María, después de completar su vida terrenal, asumió cuerpo y alma en la gloria celestial.
- 20.—**La Coronación** de María; tradición de la Iglesia Católica, basada del Apocalipsis (12, 1). Apareció en el cielo una señal grandiosa: una mujer, vestida del sol, con la luna bajo sus pies, y una corona de doce estrellas sobre su cabeza.
