

### MISSION STATEMENT

*“We, the community of St. Gregory Barbarigo, are called forth in Baptism to follow the mission of Jesus to teach, to love, and to serve.”*

After about two months of our Faith Forward Campaign we have \$3.4M pledged and \$1.5M in cash. Thank you for the great start to this campaign. The diocese requires that we have  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the cash and  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the total pledged before we start a project. We have enough pledged to cover either phase and will shortly have enough cash. If you have not done so, it is time to start paying on your pledges! Below I want to explain how we are planning to proceed.

We are planning to build the North Building first (Phase 2), then work on the church and Parish Hall (Phase 1). Why? I want to do the work on the church beginning shortly after Easter and completing it before Christmas, but that is not possible this year. It will take until August at the earliest to draw detailed plans and begin construction, and if we start the church in August, we will have construction through Christmas and Easter. I do not want that disruption of our worship at these key times. Doing the majority of the construction during the summer months allows us to have a shorter construction period (-shorter time of disruption of services) and to avoid disrupting Christmas and Easter celebrations, the busiest times for church use. The building North of the school is relatively isolated, and will not interfere nearly as much with either school or other activities on campus.

Where are we now? We are currently hiring a Construction Manager. He and the architects will draw up detailed plans between now and about August (5 – 6 months). Then the jobs will be bid out (four – six weeks). At this point, we will have a better idea of how much things are going to cost, as our estimates will be more accurate. We hope to begin construction by September. With some luck we could have the dirt moved and the concrete foundation poured, maybe even the building enclosed before the snow falls. That would allow us to work inside during winter. If not, it will extend the building time. In any case, we would hope to connect the North building with the North side of the school during the summer to avoid disruption of school. We think it may take a little over a year to finish the building, weather and availability of the workers permitting. By the way, we intend to have as much work done locally as possible.

How are we going to pay for the construction? The diocese is going to extend a line of credit to us and loan us the money. Our track record with them is good and we will have  $\frac{1}{2}$  the cash and the total cost of the North building in pledges covered. They will charge us interest, but less than the going rate. The sooner you get your pledges in, the less we will have to borrow from the diocese, and the less interest we will have to pay. So please keep paying on those pledges – the time is coming soon when we will have to spend the money, and architecture fees and construction costs will go out faster than our income since we have three-year pledges and estimated one-year of construction!

Meanwhile, we are going to continue fund raising to get the money for the church expansion and hopefully will have  $\frac{1}{2}$  the cash and  $\frac{3}{4}$  the total in pledges to begin the church and Parish Hall expansion by Spring 2026. Many of you have pledged and we have begun well. THANK YOU! There are still others who have not yet pledged, and we are hoping you can come aboard to join in our effort to prepare the church for this coming century of service to Maryville and Nodaway County.

See our children hard at work this week in the atrium!




St. Gregory Families,

Due to the extended weekend, preschool and Pre-K did not meet in the atrium. Children in kindergarten heard the parable of the "Hidden Treasure". They wondered about what treasure would be so great that one would sell all they had to purchase the field in which it was buried. The first grade heard, "The Yeast" and saw what yeast can do when mixed with flour and water. By the end of the atrium session they saw the dough mixed with yeast and understood the meaning of "leavened" when they saw it rise. The children in second grade worked on the synthesis of the Holy Mass. This work involved placing the articles of the Mass to match the words used. Some of the articles included the paten, chalice, crucifix, and ciborium. Children in 3rd grade worked on "The Good Shepherd and the Hireling/Wolf and the 10 Bridesmaids. 




