

Saint Andrew Respect Life Committee

When we face setbacks, it's easy to get discouraged.

Yet the sky has not fallen on the pro-life movement. Election results fluctuate, but the pro-life cause endures. MCCL's mission continues. It remains necessary and urgent. Saint Teresa of Calcutta, a pro-life champion, perhaps said it best: We are called, "not to be successful, but to be faithful."

MCCL (Minnesota Citizens Concerned for Life) is preparing to face the difficulties of 2021, to take advantage of our opportunities to make a lifesaving difference, and – in all of this – to be faithful to our mission of protecting the most vulnerable members of the human family.

At the federal level, the coming years will pose great challenges. The Biden administration has promised to quickly use executive orders to fund groups that perform or promote abortion overseas, and to redirect Title X taxpayer funding back to groups involved in the destructive business of abortion, like Planned Parenthood.

Yet, there is cause for optimism, too. We'll work to inform the public about anti-life actions in Washington, and to build support for pro-life policies. We are hopeful that pro-life members of Congress can prevent the worst legislation from passing. The federal courts have clearly shifted in the right direction over the last few years (though Biden promises his own judicial appointments will take a very different course).

Here in Minnesota, we still don't have a pro-life governor. But, with many pro-life victories in the state legislative races last fall, there are now narrow pro-life majorities in both chambers of the state legislature.

MCCL will continue to work each day at the Capitol to advance pro-life public policy. That includes legislation to finally ban taxpayer funding of abortion in Minnesota. And it includes working to stop anti-life legislation from getting to the governor's desk.

We expect that there will be an attempt this year to cut funding for the lifesaving Positive Alternative program. That's a grant program MCCL helped begin, to support pregnant women and new mothers. Since the program went into effect in 2006, it has helped more than 68,000 families, according to the Department of Health.

Since it was founded in 1968, MCCL has worked to secure protection for innocent human life from conception until natural death through education, legislation and political action. Our structure and our multi-pronged strategy, and most of all, the support of pro-lifers like you, have made us effective.

We have come a long way, and we have made a big difference. Yet, there is still a long way to go. Together, we will stand in solidarity with unborn children and their mothers. We will speak out for the voiceless. We will, no matter what, choose "to be faithful" to the cause of life.
