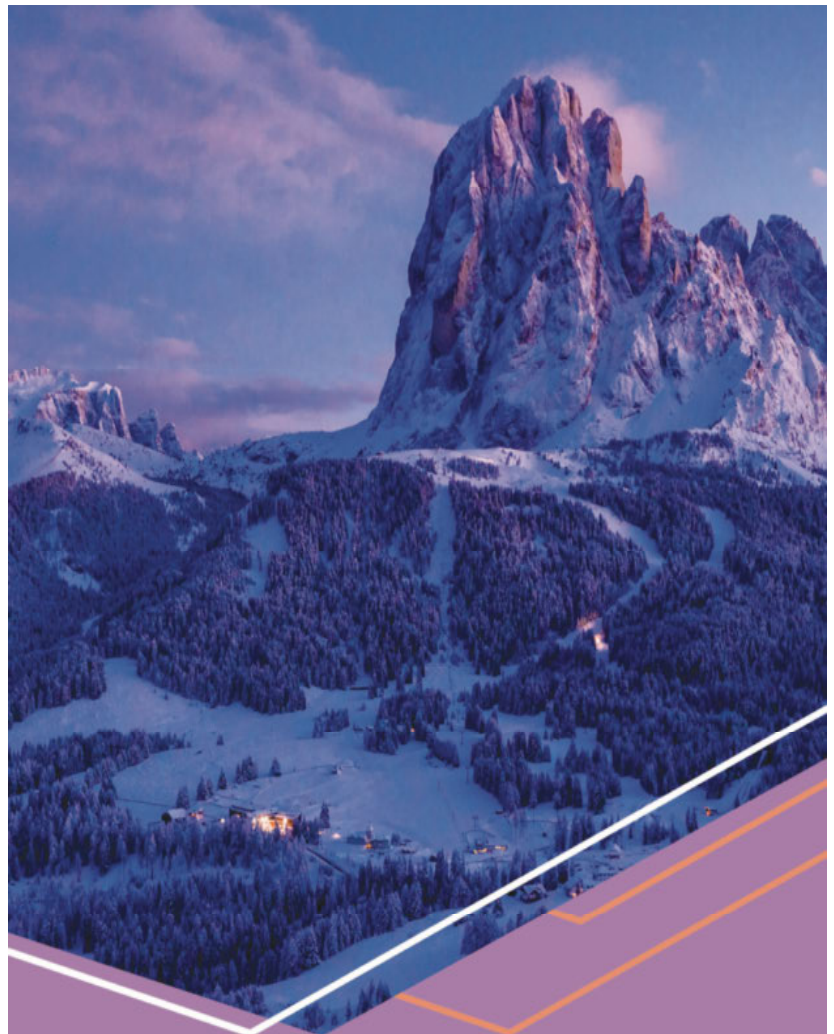

Schulze Family Foundation Challenge Grant

Saint Andrew Catholic School is excited to participate in a \$25,000 Challenge Grant offered by the Schulze Family Foundation.

This grant opportunity will fill an essential area for our youngest students at Saint Andrew, a playground that is just their size! A preliminary budget of \$70,000 will create an area on the campus just for children 5 years old and under. This will be our first step towards the future expansion of our school. Our overarching goal is to return to two sections in each grade and then explore adding grades 6, 7, and 8 back to our school. This is step one of this large goal, and we need all the help we can get!

 The Immigrant Community Organizer is primarily responsible for bringing people together to work on the social problems of economically distressed areas and immigrant populations. The work is completed in collaboration among three different roles: the (1) Rural Life, (2) Immigrant and (3) Refugee Community Organizer.
