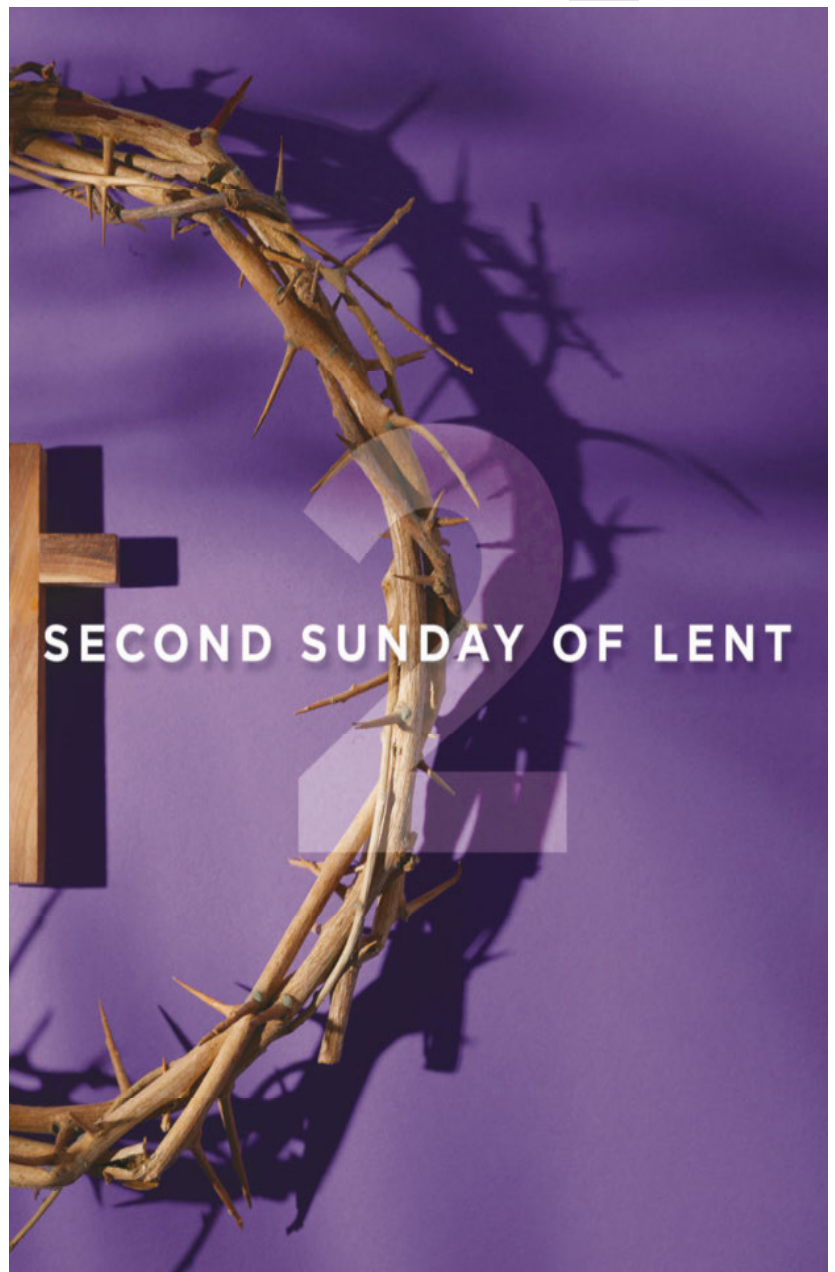

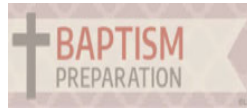
**A prayer for Lent**

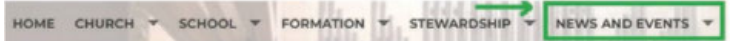

It's designed to enable you to have a deeper experience of yourself as a person, your relationship with God and with your community.

Wherever you are in your faith journey, CEW will help you move a step further. Through witness talks, prayer, faith-sharing and fellowship, you'll experience a transformative encounter with God.

Saint Andrew will host two CEW retreats, one for men on May 6-8 and one for women on May 13-15. The weekend begins on Friday evening and concludes on Sunday afternoon.

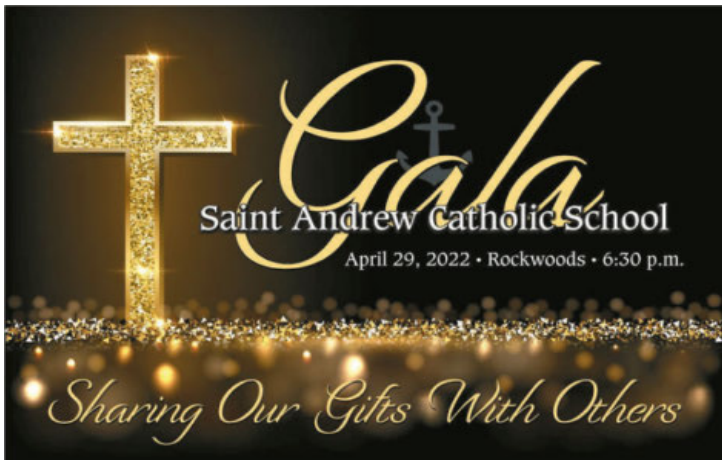
