From The Desk of The Pastor

Dear Parishioners:

This weekend, we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord. The word Epiphany means to manifest. Epiphany celebrates the manifestation of Himself as the Christ to the Gentiles. This is signaled through the arrival of the Three Kings. "We have seen His star in the east and have come with gifts to adore the Lord." *Matthew 2:2*

Epiphany clearly shows that the Lord is the Savior of the world! He came not only to save the Jewish people, He came to save all people. Epiphany was originally celebrated on January 6th, the 12th day of Christmas, until a number of years ago it was transferred to the Sunday near January 6th. Even though the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord signals the end of the Christmas Season, Epiphany on the date of January 6th signaled the end of the main days of the Christmas Season.

Epiphany is known as the "Little Christmas" because in the eastern part of the world, they exchange gifts for Christmas on Epiphany because of the Three Kings bringing special gifts to our Lord. They brought gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. Gold because Jesus was the King of Kings. Frankincense because He was the Son of God and Priest of Priests. Myrrh because Jesus would die for the people. Myrrh is a yellowish brown to reddish brown aromatic gum resin used to make an ointment to anoint a body of a deceased loved one.

As we celebrate the Epiphany may the feast remind us to always give the Lord adoration and homage as did the Three Kings. We do not have gold, frankincense and myrrh to give the Lord, but we can give Him our faith, hope, and love. As the Lord was really present to the Three Kings in the manger, the Lord is really present to us in the Blessed Sacrament. May we always truly adore our Lord's presence in the Blessed Sacrament! As the Lord touched the hearts of the Three Kings with His love, the Lord will touch our hearts through His Divine Presence in the Blessed Sacrament.

Yes, Jesus is the Savior of the World, let us give Him adoration and homage.

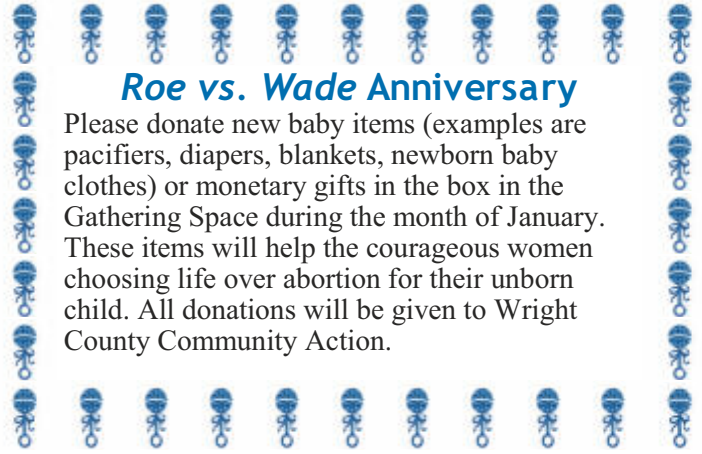


While our Adoration Chapel remains closed during the Pandemic for safety reasons, the church will be open the following times for private prayer:
