Psalm 23 The Lord, Shepherd and Host


"The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.

Bishops Sunday Obligation

The Bishops of MN have put back on the obligation to attend mass on the weekend and Holy Days starting July 3 & 4. People are only excused from the obligation to attend mass on the weekend and Holy Days under the following circumstances per the Bishops:

- 1. You have reason to believe your health would be significant compromised if you were to contact a communicable illness. (You have underlying health conditions or are in a high risk category.)
- 2. You exhibit flu-like symptoms.
- 3. You have good reason to think you might be asymptomatic of a contagious illness (eg. You were in recent contact with someone who tested positive for a contagious illness such as COVID or influenza).
- 4. You care for the sick, homebound, or infirmed.
- 5. You are pregnant or are 65 years of age or older (per the CDC's recommendation for high risk individuals).
- 6. You cannot attend mass through no fault of your own (eg. no mass offered, you are infirm; or while wanting to go, you are prevented for some reason you cannot control, such as your ride did not show up.)
- 7. You have significant fear or anxiety of becoming ill by being at Mass.

St. Lawrence, Deacon & Martyr—Feast Day August 10

The year was 258 A.D. It was a difficult beginning for what would become the First Christian Millennium. Hostility against the early followers of Jesus Christ was growing. The barbarism and severity of pagan Rome had begun to reach a fever pitch. It would soon lead to a blood lust. The newborn Christian Church, faithful to the One who had given Himself for the life of the world, continued the work of His redemption.

Sentenced to death in the Emperor Valerian's sweeping condemnation of all Christian clergy, Lawrence offended the Emperor - and endeared himself to all Christians since then - by assembling before Valerian the real gold and silver of the Church, the poor.

According to the Christian tradition, Deacon Lawrence, knowing that the fervor of Valerians' hatred was extending to all Christians who owned property, distributed the money and treasures of the Church to the city's poor-believing the clear admonition of the Savior that they were blessed and especially loved by Him.

The tradition records massive conversions to the Christian faith as a result of the holy life and death of one Deacon who understood the true heart of his vocation. He was poured out, like his Master, Jesus Christ the Servant, in redemptive love, on behalf of others. It is still said to this day that all of Rome became Christian as a result of the faithful life, and the death, of this one humble deacon.
