From the Desk of the Pastor

Dear Parishioners;

In the Gospel this weekend we hear about the Visitation, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Joyful Mystery. The Blessed Mother goes to visit her cousin Elizabeth who was pregnant with John the Baptist. The Blessed Mother went to help Elizabeth with the housework so that she could rest as she prepared for the birth of John the Baptist. This has become a lost tradition, which was a beautiful and loving tradition. Elizabeth appreciated the Blessed Mother's visit. And when the Blessed Mother arrived, Elizabeth knew by the power of the Holy Spirit that it was not just her cousin visiting her, but that it was the Mother of the Lord visiting her!

The Visitation reminds us that we should take time to visit our family members, relatives, friends, and neighbors. Just like we appreciate when someone takes time and makes the effort to visit us, so too we should take time and make the effort to visit others. When we are in the neighborhood, we should take time to visit loved ones and friends. Even a short visit is better than no visit! We do not want to have regrets at a funeral that we should take 5 or 10 minutes to visit with a neighborhood in which we live, we should take 5 or 10 minutes to visit with a neighbor when we are outside. Through visits we can get to know them. For some people those visits have led to the neighbors becoming friends, even good friends! And in this day and age we know that a number of people do not know who their neighbors are because of the lack of visits!

When we visit another human being we encounter the Lord. We know the Lord said that if we welcome someone we welcome Him! And we always want to welcome the Lord!

When we visit someone we get to know them and we begin to connect with them. We grow in love and care for them. We learn that others have some of the same dreams, goals, and aspirations as we do.

Let us renew our efforts to visit others like the Blessed Mother visited Elizabeth. And let us always appreciate it when others visit us; even when it is inconvenient, remembering they care about us that they took the time to visit.
