

NATURAL FAMILY PLANNING INTRODUCTORY SESSION

Are you interested in knowing more about family planning that is holy and faithful, and has great benefits for your marriage and your family? Are you struggling with difficulty conceiving or maintaining a pregnancy? Or are you a woman who suffers from painful or irregular cycles?

Modern natural fertility care is as effective as any of the chemical and barrier methods of birth control and has none of the dangerous side effects. It is more effective at helping couples achieve a pregnancy than artificial technologies. It can also be used to diagnose and treat female health conditions. Best of all, it is completely faithful to the Gospel.

An introductory session for the Creighton Model of Natural Family Planning will be offered at St. Michael the Archangel Parish on Wednesday, May 18, 7 –8 p.m. in the multi-purpose room located in the school. This class is open to all engaged and married couples. (It satisfies the marriage preparation NFP requirement.) It is also open to single women who are interested in learning how to use the Creighton Model to track their own health.

Sunday is the fourth Sunday of Easter, also known as *Good Shepherd Sunday*. In the Gospel reading at Mass Jesus says, "*My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish.*"

Discuss: At every Mass, the Good Shepherd is with His sheep in a particular way. He calls his sheep by name, and they listen to his voice in the Scripture. Then the Good Shepherd is present in the bread and the wine at Holy Eucharist.

Question: What can we do to make Sunday the most important day of each week? What are other ways we can hear God's voice?
