

Here are the rest of the books recommended by international Catholic speaker and author, Katie Prejean. The first 3 on the list can be found in the June 20th bulletin.

- **4) 61 Minutes to a Miracle: The True Story of a Family's Devotion** (Bonnie L. Engstrom, Our Sunday Visitor). This book tells of the miraculous healing of the author's son, James Fulton, who was born stillborn in September of 2010. In the 61 minutes that her son didn't have a heartbeat, the Engstroms prayed intentionally for the intercession of Archbishop Fulton Sheen, and their son was miraculously healed. This book will move hearts and change lives.
- 5) Chasing Humility: 8 Ways to Shape a Christian Heart (Joel Stepanek, Ave Maria Press). We don't want humility, but we're called to humility. The balance of those two facts leads to holiness. 


