

IN THE PARISH

Children's and Youth Faith Formation Volunteers Needed: Can you help?

As our plans for children and youth programs develop, many volunteers are needed. Your help is appreciated! To volunteer, contact Mary Nowakowski at maryn@holyspiritrochester.org.

Family Catechesis for Families with Students in Grades 1-8 (Hybrid program)

Adult volunteers are needed to lead student classroom sessions 4-5 times per year on either Wednesdays from 6:15-7:30 PM or Sundays from 11:15 AM-12:45 PM.

Time commitment is about 3-4 hours per session which includes 2 hours of preparation and leading the session. Parents and students gather together at church for the first lesson of the unit. Families meet together and then students separate to go to classrooms where adult volunteers teach the first lesson of the unit. Parents and students complete the remaining four lessons of the unit at home on their own schedule.

Modified Family Catechesis for Parents and Students in Grades 1-8

Parents and students gather together at church for the first lesson of the unit. Families meet together and then students separate to go to classrooms where adult volunteers teach the first lesson of the unit. Parents take turns teaching their own children the remaining 4 lessons of the unit in a classroom at church. (The modified program will be offered if there is adequate enrollment.)

Sparks Sunday School For Ages 3-5 and Kindergarten

We'd like to resume our Sparks Sunday School program. In order to do so, adult and high school students in grades 10-12 are needed to lead Sunday school classes. Time commitment is about 2 hours twice per month, which includes 30 minutes of preparation at home, and 1.5 hours at church preparing classrooms and teaching Sunday School during a weekend Mass.

Adult volunteers will determine at which Masses the Sparks program will be offered. Once volunteers are in place, we will begin registration for the Sparks program.

Children's Liturgy of the Word For Ages 4-7 years

Adult leaders and high school helpers are needed for this program.

Time Commitment is 1.5 hours twice per month and includes reading the material at home and then leading CLW during the Mass.

Depending on volunteer preference, CLW may be offered at any of Holy Spirit's three Masses. Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLW) is a program in which the Sunday scripture readings are proclaimed and explained on a level appropriate for children ages 4-7.

Children gather with the leaders at the front of church after the Opening Prayer and are sent forth by the presider. The group will go to the St. Joseph Room for an opening prayer, then listen as the First Reading from the Children's

Lectionary is proclaimed. Leaders then lead the group in singing a Psalm and Gospel Acclamation. Next, the Gospel reading is proclaimed followed by reflection on the Word through stories, discussions or pictures—whatever the leader finds most appropriate to convey the meaning of the scriptures. Following this, there is an Act of Faith and then prayers or Intercession. Children return to their families at the Presentation of the Gifts. No registration is needed for CLW.

Floor Committee Update


Your voice has been heard and a new layout will be introduced in August. The Finish the Floor committee has been working with Fr Tom and an architect to incorporate changes based upon the feedback from the first pilot. That has led to a broadening of our options to include moving the altar toward the north wall and arranging the seating in a semicircle. The new plan is designed to improve site lines, traffic flow, and to find the best way to celebrate the Eucharist as a community in this space along with baptisms, funerals, and weddings. More information will be in next week's bulletin providing more details and some of the rationale that went into this second pilot.


Contact the parish office six months before the wedding celebration for preparation requirements.


