From the Pastor/Parish News

Pastoral Conversion of the Parish Community

Recognizing the profound change in the social context of parishes today, the office of the *Congregation of Clergy from Vatican* has issued on July 27, 2020, a new instruction for the renewal of the parish with a missionary focus. Pope Francis has already approved this document. Let me summarize the key points of this document guiding the parish community.

While parishes being indispensable places for encountering Christ and fostering living and loving relationship with one another, parishes need to face changes exploring creative ways to serve the mission of evangelization. The new approach urges parishes to shift focus from merely adding membership to fostering discipleship and maintaining its divine mission.

A new synergy between ministers and diverse charisms and gifts needs to be fostered to cultivate an environment for the “pastoral care for all.” The pastoral care of all cannot be realized without the whole hearted engagement and contribution of all the baptized: priests, deacons and laity. When we are baptized, we are in fact chosen by God not for ourselves but for the sake of the world. Pope Francis urges all the baptized to journey together not just as individuals but as a “close-bond community of all for all.” This vision demands that the historical parish institution not remain a prisoner of immobility or worrisome pastoral repetition for self-preservation; rather, it should put into action an outgoing dynamism resulting from the collaboration of all to fulfill the mission of the church.

Underscoring the urgency of parish renewal, new canonical norms are issued to Bishops, priests and laity clarifying their respective roles and responsibilities. The purpose of this new directive is to help each parish rediscover itself as a fundamental place of evangelical proclamation, celebration of the Eucharist; places of fraternity and charity from which Christian witness can shine for the world. “The parish, that is, must remain a place of creativity, of relationship, of motherhood. When the parish moves forward in this way, it is really a ‘parish on the move’ and cannot remain stagnant.”

Pope Francis invites us to invoke Mary, Mother of Evangelization, so that the Virgin may help us to say our own “yes,” conscious of the urgent need to make the good news of Jesus resound in our time. A certain holy audacity and renewed zeal is necessary to dis-



cover new ways to bring the gift of salvation to everyone.

This prolonged situation of Covid-19 might create moments for each of us to rediscover the beauty of our own baptismal call and realize our missionary mandate with a new vigor and fervor.

Del Párroco / Noticias Parroquiales

Conversión Pastoral de la Comunidad Parroquial

Reconociendo el profundo cambio en el contexto social de las parroquias hoy, la oficina de la **Congregación del Clero del Vaticano** emitió el 27 de julio de 2020, una nueva instrucción para la renovación de la parroquia con un enfoque misionero. El Papa Francisco ya aprobó este documento. Permítanme resumir los puntos clave de este documento que guían a la comunidad parroquial.

Si bien las parroquias son lugares indispensables para encontrar a Cristo y fomentar una relación viva y amorosa entre sí, las parroquias deben enfrentar cambios explorando formas creativas para servir a la misión de evangelización. El nuevo enfoque insta a las parroquias a cambiar el enfoque de simplemente agregar membresía a fomentar el discipulado y mantener su misión divina.

Es necesario fomentar entre los ministros una nueva sinergia y diversos carismas y dones para cultivar un ambiente "pastoral para todos". El cuidado pastoral de todos no puede realizarse sin el compromiso y la contribución de todo corazón de todos los bautizados: sacerdotes, diáconos y laicos. Cuando somos bautizados, de hecho, somos elegidos por Dios no por nosotros mismos, sino por el bien del mundo. El Papa Francisco insta a todos los bautizados a caminar juntos no solo como individuos, sino como una "comunidad estrecha de todos para todos". Esta visión exige que la histórica institución parroquial no quede prisionera de la inmovilidad o de la preocupante repetición pastoral para la auto conservación; más bien, debe poner en acción un dinamismo extrovertido resultante de la colaboración de todos para cumplir la misión de la Iglesia.

Subrayando la urgencia de la renovación parroquial, se emiten nuevas normas canónicas a los obispos, sacerdotes y laicos aclarando sus respectivos roles y responsabilidades. El propósito de esta nueva directiva es ayudar a cada parroquia a redescubrirse como lugar fundamental del anuncio evangélico, celebración de la Eucaristía; lugares de fraternidad y caridad desde los que el testimonio cristiano pueda brillar para el mundo. "La parroquia, es decir, debe seguir siendo un lugar de creatividad, de relación, de maternidad. Cuando la parroquia avanza de esta manera, realmente es una 'parroquia en movimiento' y no puede permanecer estancada".

El Papa Francisco nos invita a invocar a María, Madre

de la Evangelización, para que la Virgen nos ayude a decir nuestro propio "sí", conscientes de la urgente necesidad de hacer resonar en nuestro tiempo la buena nueva de Jesús. Es necesaria una santa audacia y un celo renovado para descubrir nuevos caminos para llevar el don de la salvación a todos.

Esta situación prolongada de Covid-19 podría crear momentos para que cada uno de nosotros redescubra la belleza de nuestro propio llamado bautismal y realice nuestro mandato misionero con un nuevo vigor y fervor.

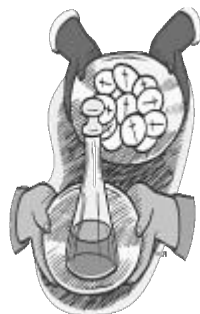

Corpus Christi Parish in Council Bluffs and Carter Lake, Iowa, is seeking a full-time Coordinator of Faith Formation (CRE) for grades K-10. Corpus Christi has about 1,450 families with over 150 students in our faith formation program. The Coordinator of Faith Formation must have strong communication and organizational skills as well as dedication to the importance of good catechesis in growing the faith of our youth.
