From the Pastor/Parish News

Protecting the dignity and Right of Laborers

Jesus placed the plight of the poor in the center of his heart when he said, "Come to me all those labor and are heavy burdened, I will give you rest" (Mathew 11:28). We are created in the image and likeness of God and designed to experience success and fulfillment through the ethic of hard work and dignified labor. As Christians, we need to see work as an opportunity to serve God and humanity.

The celebration of Labor Day began in the United States in the year 1894 as a federal holiday to honor the rights and dignity of American workers. The Church teaches us that the economy should provide opportunity for work and living wages for all those who work safe-guarding their dignity and rights. The United States Conference of Bishops exhorts, "Work is more than a way to make a living, it is a form of continuous participation in God's creation". If the dignity of work is to be protected, then the basic rights of workers must be respected--the right to productive work, to decent and fair wages, to the organization and joining of unions, to private property, and to economic initiative" (uscgb.org).

All too often though, in our society, the poor and vulnerable are left without opportunities for adequate employment and support. As Catholics, we must fight to create fair opportunities for all assuring their dignity and just wages. Pope Emeritus Benedict states, "The most serious of the evils that afflict the world these days are youth unemployment and the loneliness of the old. The old need care and companionship; the young need work and hope but have neither one nor the other, and the problem is they don't even look for them anymore. They have been crushed by the present. You tell me: can you live crushed under the weight of the present? Without a memory of the past and without the desire to look ahead to the future by building something, a future, a family? Can you go on like this? Francis exhorts, "Work, in fact, directly concerns the human person, his life, his freedom and his happiness. The primary value of work is the good of the human person since it fulfills him as such, with his inner talents and his intellectual, creative and physical abilities. Hence the scope of work is not only profit and economics; its purpose above all regards man and his dignity... This dignity is wounded where work is lacking! Anyone who is unemployed or underemployed is likely, in fact, to be placed on the margins of society, becoming a victim of social exclusion.

Right now, millions of Americans have lost their jobs and many are vulnerable to sickness and death since they cannot access affordable health care. How can we as individual Catholics support the rights and dignity of workers? As parishioners how can we advocate legislation which supports the rights of workers, the dignity of labor, health care for every one in this pandemic times and a living wage for the families. If we are in a position of employing people, we should make sure to grant the minimum wage of \$15 per hour as per the recommendation of our Diocese. Op-



portunities for growth and health benefits for all to the best of our abilities. Our parish took steps to implement the diocesan recommendation of the minimum wage for our employees last year.

"The joys and the hopes, the griefs and the anxieties of the people of this age, especially those who are poor or in any way afflicted, these are the joys and hopes, the griefs and anxieties of the followers of Christ." (*Gaudium Et Spes*, 1965, 1). I hope we can begin to apply the principles Dignity, Justice and Respect rooted in the Catholic Social teaching in the place of employment, communities and our nation and thus be champions of the poor and marginalized workers.

Del Párroco / Noticias Parroquiales

Protección de la Dignidad y los Derechos de los Trabajadores

Jesús colocó la difícil situación de los pobres en el centro de su corazón cuando dijo: “Vengan a mí todos los que están afligidos y agobiados, yo los haré descansar.” (Mateo 11:28). Somos creados a imagen y semejanza de Dios y diseñados para experimentar el éxito y la realización a través de la ética del trabajo duro y el trabajo digno. Como cristianos, debemos ver el trabajo como una oportunidad para servir a Dios y a la humanidad.

La celebración del Día del Trabajo comenzó en los Estados Unidos en el año 1894 como un día feriado federal para honrar los derechos y la dignidad de los trabajadores estadounidenses. La Iglesia nos enseña que la economía debe brindar oportunidades de trabajo y salarios dignos para todos aquellos que trabajan salvaguardando su dignidad y derechos. La Conferencia de Obispos de los Estados Unidos exhorta: “El trabajo es más que una forma de ganarse la vida, es una forma de participación continua en la creación de Dios”. Si se quiere proteger la dignidad del trabajo, se deben respetar los derechos básicos de los trabajadores: el derecho al trabajo productivo, a un salario decente y justo, a la organización y afiliación de sindicatos, a la propiedad privada y a la iniciativa económica”. Sin embargo, con demasiada frecuencia, en nuestra sociedad, los pobres y vulnerables se quedan sin oportunidades de empleo y apoyo adecuados. Como católicos, debemos luchar para crear oportunidades justas para todos asegurando su dignidad y salarios justos. El Papa Emérito Benedicto XVI declara: “El más grave de los males que afligen al mundo en estos días es el desempleo juvenil y la soledad de los ancianos. Los ancianos necesitan cuidados y compañía; los jóvenes necesitan trabajo y esperanza pero no tienen ni lo uno ni lo otro, y el problema es que ya ni siquiera los buscan. Han sido aplastados por el presente. Tú me dices: ¿puedes vivir aplastado bajo el peso del presente? ¿Sin recuerdo del pasado y sin ganas de mirar hacia el futuro construyendo algo, un futuro, una familia? ¿Puedes seguir así? El Papa Francisco exhorta: “El trabajo, de hecho, concierne directamente a la persona humana, su vida, su libertad y su felicidad. El valor primordial del trabajo es el bien de la persona humana, ya que lo llena como tal, con sus talentos internos y sus capacidades intelectuales, creativas y físicas. Por tanto, el ámbito del trabajo no es sólo el beneficio y la economía; su finalidad se refiere sobre todo al hombre y su dignidad. . . ¡Esta dignidad se hiere donde falta trabajo! Cualquiera que esté desempleado o subempleado es probable, de hecho, quedar al margen de la sociedad, convirtiéndose en víctima de la exclusión social.

En este momento, millones de estadounidenses han perdido sus trabajos y muchos son vulnerables a la enfermedad y la muerte, ya que no pueden acceder a una atención médica asequible. ¿Cómo podemos nosotros, como católicos individuales, apoyar los derechos y la dignidad de los trabajadores? Como feligreses, ¿cómo podemos defender una legislación que apoye los derechos de los trabajadores, la dignidad del trabajo, la atención médica para todos en esta época de pandemia y un salario digno para las familias? Si estamos en condiciones de emplear personas, debemos asegurarnos de otorgar el salario mínimo de \$15 por hora según la recomendación de nuestra Diócesis. Oportunidades de crecimiento y beneficios para la salud para todos en la medida de nuestras posibilidades. Nuestra parroquia tomó medidas para implementar la recomendación diocesana del salario mínimo para nuestros empleados el año pasado.

“Las alegrías y las esperanzas, los dolores y las angustias de la gente de esta época, especialmente los que son pobres o afligidos de alguna manera, estos son los gozos y esperanzas, los dolores y las angustias de los seguidores de Cristo”. (Gaudium et Spes, 1965, 1). Espero que podamos comenzar a aplicar los principios de Dignidad, Justicia y Respeto arraigados en la Doctrina Social Católica en el lugar del empleo, las comunidades y nuestra nación y así ser campeones de los trabajadores pobres y marginados.

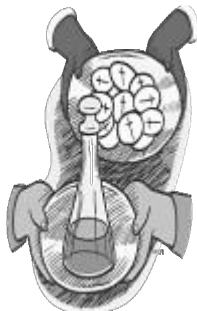

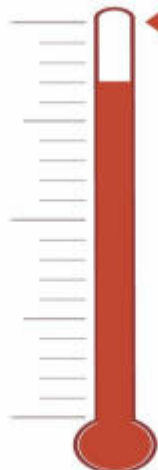
