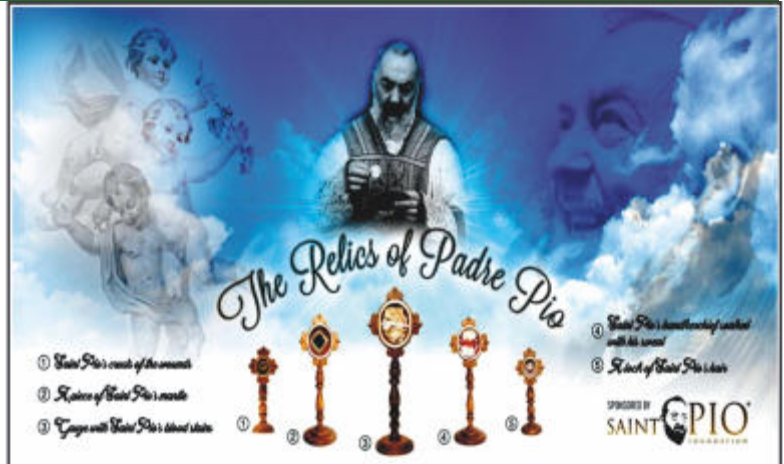

(Dr. Castle is the founder of LIFE Runners, the world's largest Pro-Life team.)

Padre Pio has been called, "A Saint for Our Times." Ordained a priest in 1910, in 1918 the five wounds of our Lord's passion appeared on his body, making him the first stigmatized priest in the history of the Catholic Church. His whole life was marked by long hours of prayer and continual austerity.

His letters to his spiritual directors reveal the ineffable suffering, physical and spiritual, which accompanied him all through his life. They also reveal his deep union with God, his burning love for the Blessed Eucharist and Our Blessed Lady. In 1940, he developed a Home for the Relief of Suffering for all of God's children in pain in body or soul. Padre Pio's international network of prayer groups for the support of the facility continues to live on and grow today.

Worn out by over half a century of intense suffering and constant apostolic activity, Padre Pio died on September 23, 1968. On June 16, 2002, Pope John Paul II proclaimed Padre Pio, "Saint Pio of Pietrelcina".

From the Pastor/Parish News

Family of Faith

During the last three months, we have been thinking how best to enhance the quality of our faith formation and its impact on our families. Our faith formation program is very well organized and focused on sacramental preparations, while not seriously engaging the parents to assimilate the deeper values of faith and engage the hearts of the whole family. While we have a great faith handed down from the time of the Apostles, there is a big gap between the faith of our fathers and the current faith level of the families. As a result, there are millions of families falling away from our precious faith. I have been talking with parents, catechists, parish leaders, diocese and young families as to what it will take to turn this situation around so that we can fall in love with God and experience the power and beauty of authentic faith becoming the center of our families.

The idea of the *Family of Faith* has been gaining momentum across United States for the last five years and I learn that Sophia Institute for faith formation has been working with over 300 American Parishes to launch the *Family of Faith* formation program. *The focus of the "Family of Faith" is to help develop strong families in which the children experience the joy of following Jesus Christ and truths of our faith through the witness of Christian life given by their parents.* Suzanne Walsh from the Sophia Institute has been helping us become familiar with the content and dynamics of the *Family of Faith* through regular Zoom sessions.

In the diocese of Omaha, there are 12 parishes that have begun this program. Fr. Enrique and I and the parish staff talked with Fr. Jeff Loseke and Jacki Schulster, director of faith formation at St. Charles Borromeo parish in Omaha and learned that their families are excited about this new direction and are delighted to see the new energy and enthusiasm of the parish. If you want to know more about their experience of *Family of Faith*, their testimonies are posted on their parish website (stcharlesomaha.org)

"Having set this new direction of *Family of Faith* our whole parish family situation is changing--learning to fall in love with our faith. I have never seen such positive change parish life in my 35 years as a pastor," noted, Fr. Michael, Pastor of Our Lady of Shoals, in Tuscumbia, Alabama. "There are great things happening when the faith becomes the center of our family life. In the Gospels, we find, Jesus blessing children and teaching the adults. On the other hand, we have been teaching children and blessing adults. This needs to change and go back to Jesus manner of teaching the adults and adults in turn teaching the children. In this way, parents become the primary teachers and mentors of faith as originally envisaged in the Catechism of the Catholic Church" (CCC 2223).

We are planning to begin the *Family of Faith* program in October for our Parish. There will be an orientation session on September 23rd at 6:30 pm to learn more about this

Familia de Fe

Durante los últimos tres meses, hemos estado pensando en la mejor manera de mejorar la calidad de nuestra formación en la fe y su impacto en nuestras familias. Nuestro programa de formación en la fe está muy bien organizado y se centra en los preparativos sacramentales, sin comprometer seriamente a los padres a asimilar los valores más profundos de la fe y comprometer los corazones de toda la familia. Si bien tenemos una gran fe transmitida desde la época de los apóstoles, existe una gran brecha entre la fe de nuestros padres y el nivel de fe actual de las familias. Como resultado, hay millones de familias que se apartan de nuestra preciosa fe. He estado hablando con padres, catequistas, líderes parroquiales, diócesis y familias jóvenes sobre lo que se necesitará para cambiar esta situación para que podamos enamorarnos de Dios y experimentar el poder y la belleza de la fe auténtica convirtiéndose en el centro de nuestras familias.

La idea de la *Familia de Fe* ha ido ganando impulso en los Estados Unidos durante los últimos cinco años y me enteré de que el Instituto Sophia para la formación en la fe ha estado trabajando con más de 300 parroquias estadounidenses para lanzar el programa de *Formación en la Fe Familiar*. *El enfoque de la "Familia de Fe" es ayudar a desarrollar familias sólidas en las que los niños experimenten el gozo de seguir a Jesucristo y las verdades de nuestra fe a través del testimonio de vida cristiana dado por sus padres.* Suzanne Walsh del Instituto Sophia nos ha estado ayudando a familiarizarnos con el contenido y la dinámica de la *Familia de Fe* a través de sesiones regulares de Zoom.

En la diócesis de Omaha, hay 12 parroquias que han comenzado este programa. El P. Enrique, el personal de la parroquia y yo hablamos con el P. Jeff Loseke y Jacki Schulster, director de formación en la fe en la parroquia St. Charles Borromeo en Omaha, se enteraron de que sus familias están entusiasmadas con esta nueva dirección y están encantadas de ver la nueva energía y entusiasmo de la parroquia. Si desea saber más sobre su experiencia de *Familia de Fe*, sus testimonios están publicados en el sitio web de su parroquia (stcharlesomaha.org). "Habiendo establecido esta nueva dirección de *Familia de Fe*, la situación familiar de toda nuestra parroquia está cambiando, aprendiendo a enamorarse de nuestra fe. Nunca había visto un cambio tan positivo en la vida parroquial en mis 35 años como párroco", señaló el P. Michael, párroco de Our Lady of Shoals, en Tuscumbia, Alabama. "Suceden grandes cosas cuando la fe se convierte en el centro de nuestra vida familiar. En los Evangelios, encontramos a Jesús bendiciendo a los niños y enseñando a los adultos. Por otro lado, hemos estado enseñando a los niños y bendiciendo a los adultos. Esto debe cambiar y volver a la manera de Jesús de enseñar a los adultos y a los adultos a su vez enseñar a los niños. De esta forma, los padres se convierten en los principales maestros y mentores de la fe, tal como se concibió originalmente en el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica" (CCC 2223).

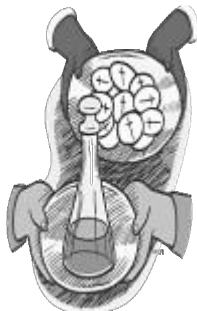
