# From the Pastor/Del Párroco

## The Mystery of the Passion of Christ

Dear Friends,

With the celebration of Palm Sunday, we enter Holy Week. And this will be a time of peace, reflection, penance, and prayer for all Christians. We journey with Christ during this final week of his intense moments: Last Supper, Crucifixion, and Rising in Glory. We trace the three faces of Jesus; The humble servant (Last Supper), the suffering servant (Good Friday), and the glorious servant (Easter Sunday). Let me share with you passages from Fathers of the Church reflecting these three faces of Christ during this Holy Week.

***The Humble Servant:*** The final journey to Jerusalem on Palm Sunday is riddled with the paradox of triumph and humility. The cries of Hosanna followed by the cries of crucifixion. “The washing of the feet and the sacrament of the Eucharist: two expressions of the same mystery of love entrusted to the disciples, so that, Jesus says, “as I have done... so also must you do” (Jn 13: 15). – St. John Paul II. Indeed, the best way to find yourself is to lose yourself in service.

***The suffering Servant:*** The Cross is the word through which God has responded to evil in the world. Sometimes it may seem as though God does not react to evil, as if he is silent. And yet, God has spoken, he has replied, and his answer is the Cross of Christ: a word which is love, mercy, forgiveness. It is also revealing a judgment, namely that God, in judging us, loves us. Remember this: God, in judging us, loves us. If I embrace his love, then I am saved, if I refuse it, then I am condemned, not by him, but myself, because God never condemns. He only loves and saves. – Pope Francis. The suffering face of Jesus is seen on the suffering face of humanity today, the sick, the lonely, the depressed, homeless, the hungry, the refugees, the immigrants, and the pandemic victims.

***The Glorious Servant:*** We give glory to You, Lord, who raised up Your cross to span the jaws of death like a bridge by which souls might pass from the region of the dead to the land of the living. We give glory to You who put on the body of a single mortal man and made it the source of life for every other mortal man. – St. Ephrem of Edessa. The glorious servant gives us hope beyond pain, suffering, and despair, for he has overcome the world. “No pain, no palm; no thorns, no throne; no gall, no glory; no cross, no crown” (William Penn).

## El Misterio de la Pasión de Cristo

Queridos amigos,

Con la celebración del Domingo de Ramos, entramos en Semana Santa. Y será un tiempo de paz, reflexión, penitencia y oración para todos los cristianos.

Caminamos con Cristo durante esta última semana de sus intensos momentos: Última Cena, Crucifixión y Resurrección en Gloria. Trazamos los tres rostros de Jesús; El siervo humilde (Última Cena), el siervo sufriente (Viernes Santo) y el siervo glorioso (Domingo de Pascua). Permítanme compartir con ustedes pasajes de los Padres de la Iglesia que reflejan estos tres rostros de Cristo durante esta Semana Santa.

**El Siervo Humilde:** El viaje final a Jerusalén el Domingo de Ramos está plagado de la paradoja del triunfo y la humildad. Los gritos de Hosanna seguidos por los gritos de crucifixión. “El lavatorio de los pies y el sacramento de la Eucaristía: dos expresiones del mismo misterio de amor confiado a los discípulos, de modo que, dice Jesús, “como yo lo he hecho ...también ustedes lo hagan” (Juan 13, 15). - San Juan Pablo II. De hecho, la mejor manera de encontrarse a sí mismo es perderse en el servicio.

**El Siervo Sufriente:** La Cruz es la palabra a través de la cual Dios ha respondido al mal en el mundo. A veces puede parecer que Dios no reacciona ante el mal, como si estuviera en silencio. Y, sin embargo, Dios ha hablado, ha respondido, y su respuesta es la Cruz de Cristo: una palabra que es amor, misericordia, perdón. También está revelando un juicio, es decir, que Dios, al juzgarnos, nos ama. Recuerda esto: Dios, al juzgarnos, nos ama. Si abrazo su amor, entonces soy salvo; si lo rechazo, entonces soy condenado, no por Él, sino por mí mismo, porque Dios nunca condena. Él solo ama y salva. - Papa Francisco. El rostro sufriente de Jesús se ve en el rostro sufriente de la humanidad de hoy, los enfermos, los solitarios, los deprimidos, los sin techo, los hambrientos, los refugiados, los inmigrantes y las víctimas de la pandemia.

**El Siervo Glorioso:** Te damos gloria, Señor, que cargaste tu cruz para cruzar las fauces de la muerte como un puente por el cual las almas pueden pasar de la región de los muertos a la tierra de los vivos. Te damos gloria a Ti que te pusiste el cuerpo de un solo hombre mortal y lo convertiste en la fuente de vida para todos los demás hombres mortales. - San Efrén de Edesa. El siervo glorioso nos da esperanza más allá del dolor, el sufrimiento y la desesperación, porque ha vencido al mundo. “Sin dolor, sin palma; sin espinas, sin trono; no hay hiel, no hay gloria; sin cruz, sin corona” (William Penn).

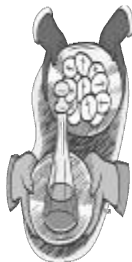

It's okay for us to be excited for Easter. We've waited so long, after all. In my opinion it's one of the best feelings there is: the yearning we have in our hearts for the Resurrection as we embark on Palm Sunday. And in a purely logical sense, many of us have Easter celebrations for which we are preparing, and practical considerations to contend with.
