

From the Desk of Father Richmond

My Beloved Parishioners:

Thank you ALL for your prayers! I am recovering from my cold but doing very well. I took some days off to get over my cold, which had been lingering on so that I can serve you better. I am praying with you.

Welcome to the Church's liturgical Season of Ordinary Time. This period consists of 33 or 34 weeks outside Advent, Christmas, and Easter seasons. During the Ordinary Time, we celebrate the mysteries of Christ that are not explicitly commemorated in the other seasons, such as Jesus' ministry of preaching, healing, and liberating. We enter into these ministries by first listening to the Lord in prayer and then carrying out these ministries in our daily lives. Like the other major seasons, the Ordinary Time invites us to live our Christian life as an encounter with God and his people, an encounter that is meant to transform us so that we can become agents of God's transformative love in the world. For this to happen, we first need to open our hearts to this transformation by making time to listen to God in prayer before we do anything. The secret to success in Christian life is Prayer before Action.

FAITH NUGGETS (Brief Catechizes)

Holiness: A Christian cannot think of his or her mission on earth without seeing it as a path of holiness, for "this is the will of God, your sanctification" (*1 Thess* 4:3). Each saint is a mission planned by the Father to reflect and embody, at a specific moment in history, a certain aspect of the Gospel. (From "Rejoice And Be Glad" para. 19)
