for you. Truly, truly, I tell you, no servant is greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him" John 13:14-16




Holy Thursday Adoration




ing for volunteers to be on our smoke alarm installation teams. You are welcome to volunteer as individuals or as teams of 3 - 4 people.
