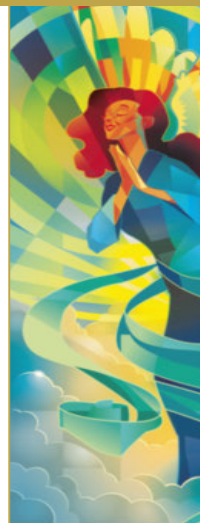

MORE GOOD NEWS...

In Luke's gospel, the angel said to the shepherds, *"I am bringing you good news of great joy for all people."* (Luke 2:10) Of course, the angel was referring to the birth of Jesus. But I would like to hire that angel to announce more good news (in case you haven't heard) . . .



The Zimmerman Church HAS BEEN SOLD! Wow, this is something to celebrate. The transaction is complete. A congregation who has been leasing a worship space in the northern suburbs of the Twin Cities, has purchased the building. They are a Slovakian WORD OF LIFE Church. Meaning that many of the members have roots from Slovakia (a country in Central Europe) and their liturgical language is Slovakian (a counterpart to Russian).

We are pleased to have them worshipping in that dear church. My hope is that they will love the building much as we did. They are already renovating parts of it. For example, new carpet is being installed in the sanctuary and some walls have been removed between offices.

As part of the sale, we agreed to leave many of the stained glass windows, the overhead lights, various desks, couches, bookcases as well as all the tables and chairs from St. Pius Hall (the basement). The white tables and chairs were donated by Our Lady's Quilters & Crafters and the discontinued St. Pius Men's Group. I wish to thank both groups, for without those items, the sale might not have gone through. For remember, we removed the pews in early summer and apparently tables and chairs are on backorder all over the country, so they would have been a church with nowhere to sit.

The removal of the pews, as well as the granite altar, granite ambo (also called a podium) and the two large Frescos were done when another group intended to purchase the building in May. When that sale dissolved, many parishioners, myself included, had second thoughts about this removal. [Note: all the aforementioned items are in storage for our future use.]

But had we NOT removed those items they probably would have been part of the sale to the WORD OF LIFE community. For the deal, from first viewing to receiving the full payment, came together in less than three weeks, which would NOT have given us a chance to remove them. And as is usually expected in a sale: affixed items were included with the purchase.

We were however able to negotiate to remove the Stations of the Cross after the closing date, as the buyers were not going to use them. They are removed, in storage and awaiting their placement as outdoor monuments along a walking trail on the new property, as outdoor Stations of the Cross. How cool is that!?

So with this sale, we are looking forward to beginning a new Capital Campaign which we are calling *IGNITE FAITH*. The campaign will begin at the end of February. It is our hope (expectation) to secure the rest of the funds needed to begin construction of the infrastructure and building on the new land. It was determined that this first phase would be a multi-purposed Social Hall (which gets transformed back and forth between a worship site and a hall for dining and large events.)

This is all very exciting! Not as big as the angel's message to the shepherds, but we are filled with similar gratitude and expectation for what's to come. Blessed "Good News" to you all.

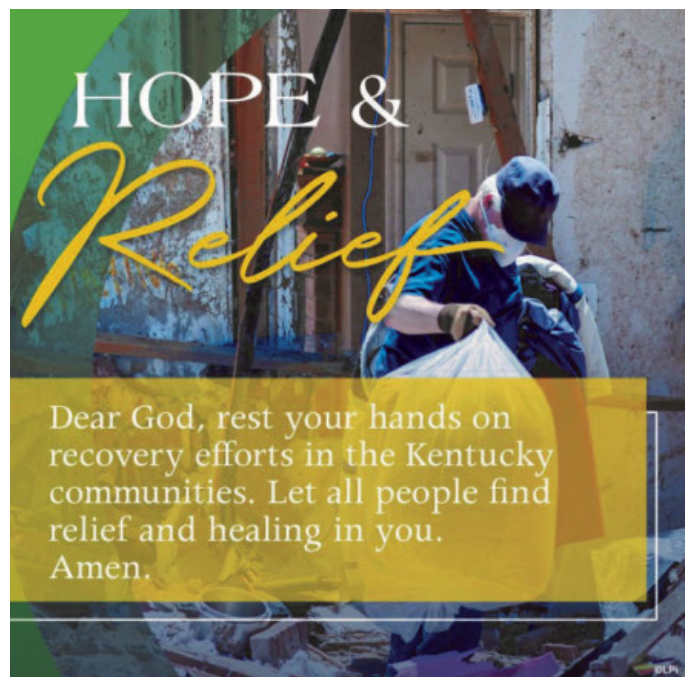
